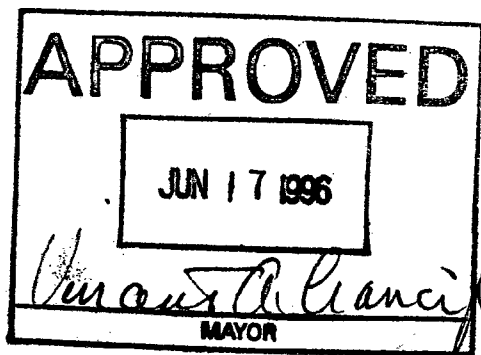

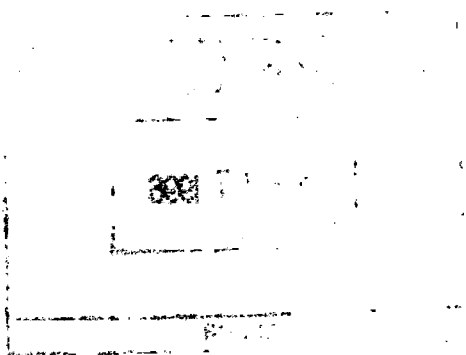



Gentlemen:

Any sidewalk cut outs either for a planned repair or an emergency, must be replaced with a like material. Temporary patch, asphalt material shall be used to optimise settlement of excavation and base compaction for thirty (30) days and final restoration to be completed within a maximum of sixty (60) days.

Also, any surrounding area disturbed by said repair, shall be cut back to the next joint and also be replaced. Said patch shall be installed in a professional manner and to insure the safety of pedestrian usage. Any deviation from city standards, specifications or time period must first receive the approval of the Director of Public Works.
