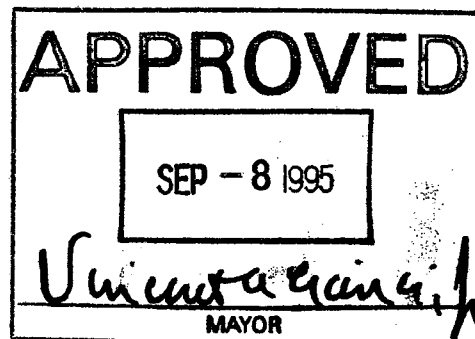
RESOLVED, That His Honor, the Mayor, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documentation relative to the transfer of Waterplace Park from the State of Rhode Island to the City of Providence. Said transfer is subject to the conditions set forth by the Committee on Finance, the City Council and His Honor, the Mayor. All documents must also be satisfactory to the City Solicitor.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that funds generated from the rental of said premises shall be segregated in an account in the general fund. The funds shall be used solely for the benefit and maintenance of Waterplace Park. Said account, created by ordinance, shall be overseen by the Finance Director of the City of Providence and the Parks Commission.
