"AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF AND IN ADDITION TO CHAPTER 68-11 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE OFFICIAL REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE MOUNT HOPE PROJECT NO. R. I. R-18"

Approved August 15, 1980

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

1. That Chapter 68-11 of the Ordinance of the City of Providence, entitled "An Ordinance Approving and Adopting the Official Redevelopment Plan for the Mount Hope Project No. R. I. R-18" as heretofore amended, be and is hereby further amended as follows:

A. A certain Section of the aforementioned Official Redevelopment Plan hereinafter identified is deleted:

(1) Section D.1.a.(2) - Public Facilities on Page 25 and;

Insert the following Section in its stead:

D.1.a. (2) Public Facilities

Public and community facilities contemplated within the project area are indicated on Map No.2, "Proposed Land Use and Zoning", and are as follows:

- a. Woodbine Street Tot Lot
- b. Knowles Street Walkway
- c. Cypress Street Playground
- d. Padelford Street Walkway
- e. Jenkins Street Elementary School

B. Map - Delete certain Map No. 2 entitled "Proposed Land Use and Zoning" dated February 16, 1973 at Page 36;

Substitute the following Map attached hereto for the aforesaid Map:

(1) Map No. 2 "Proposed Land Use and Zoning", revised June 1, 1979 at Page 36;

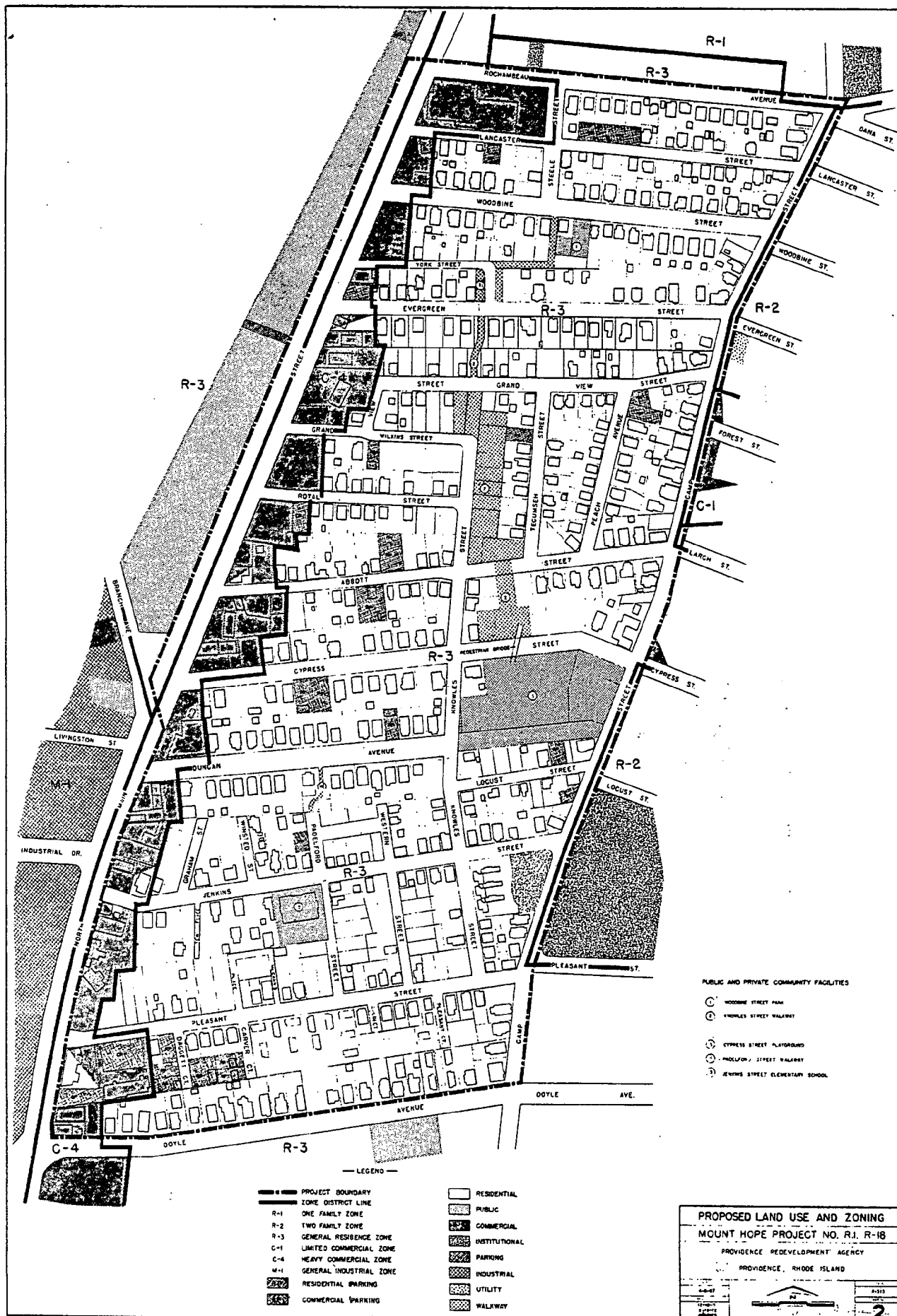
