Because I am resigning from my position at Clean Water Action on June 30, I am also resigning from my position on the Clean Energy Task Force for the City of Providence. As you know, the Task Force consists of 7 members, one of which is appointed by the Environment Council. Since December, I have served as the Chair of the Task Force.

The Task Force is in the midst of working with the City to make its first purchase of clean, renewable energy to satisfy the goal of purchasing 20% of the City's electricity from sources defined by the RES by the year 2010, as directed by the Clean Energy Ordinance.


