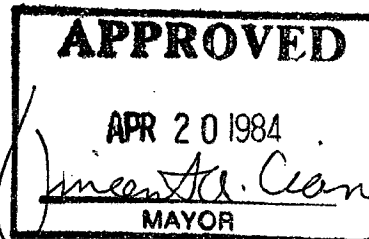
which provides that any employee who is receiving or eligible to receive disability or retirement benefits through the Employees' Retirement System of the City of Providence shall not be entitled to receive Workers' Compensation benefits.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED (2) That the City Solicitor is directed and authorized to take whatever steps are necessary to assist in the passage of said Act, substantially as set forth in the proposed bill attached.

IN AMENDMENT OF SECTION 28-31-1.1 OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF RHODE ISLAND IN CHAPTER 28-31 ENTITLED, "WORKERS' COMPENSATION - STATE AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES".

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 28-31-1.1 of the General Laws of
2 Rhode Island in chapter 28-31 entitled, "Workers Compensation -
3 State and Municipal Employees" is hereby amended to read as
4 follows:

5 28-31-1.1. Employees of the City of Providence covered.
6 The City of Providence shall be subject to and accept the
7 provisions of chapters 29 to 38, inclusive, of this title and
8 shall be governed by the provisions therein, provided, however
9 this section is not subject to §§45-13-7 through 45-13-10.

10 The City of Providence may elect to provide its employees'
11 benefits in addition to those required under this section;
12 provided, however, that any employee receiving or eligible to
13 receive disability or retirement benefits through the Employees
14 Retirement System of the City of Providence shall not be
15 entitled to the benefits of the provisions of Chapters 29 to

1 38 of this title. Any provisions of a charter, or of any
2 provision of the general or public laws inconsistent with
3 this section is hereby repealed.

4 This section shall apply to all claims of injuries occurring
5 on or after this section becomes effective for the individual
6 city or town.

7 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
