

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 541

*Approved* November 6, 1989

WHEREAS, Picerne Properties is proposing to erect a nylon pylon on property, a portion of which belongs to the City of Providence;

WHEREAS, said proposal requires review by both the Providence Zoning Board and the Committee on Public Works;

WHEREAS, the Council Committee on Public Works has requested that Picerne Properties appear before the Providence Zoning Board prior to the Committee reviewing the proposal;

WHEREAS, Picerne Properties seeks the permission of the City to appear before the Providence Zoning Board on behalf of said City with respect to the Municipal Land within the scope of the Picerne Proposal;

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to facilitate the request of the Committee on Public Works;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Picerne Properties is authorized to appear before the Providence Zoning Board on behalf of the City with respect to that parcel of land which affects the proposed pylon. The authority granted herein is conditioned in the following manner:

1. The authority granted is limited to the purpose of Picerne Properties appearance before the Providence Zoning Board and grants to Picerne Properties no interest other than that permission;
2. The same authority may be withdrawn at anytime by Resolution of the Council; and
3. The grant of authority is to be construed as neither an indication of support or as an expression of disapproval of the Petitioner's request before the Zoning Board.
