

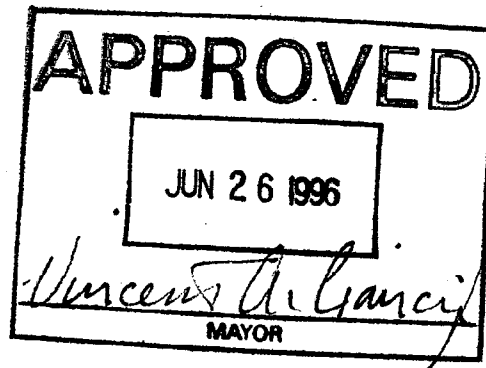

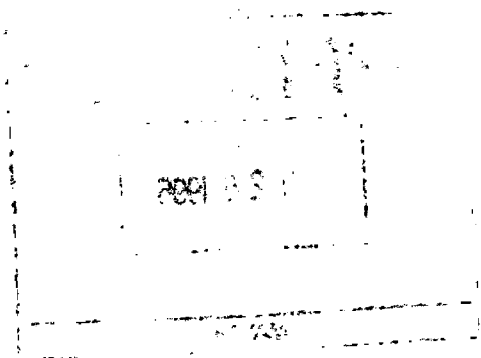

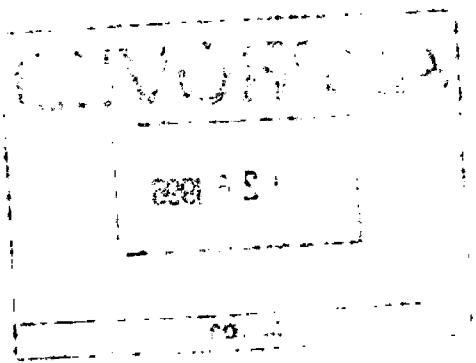

Seymour Street and Devine Street (corner)

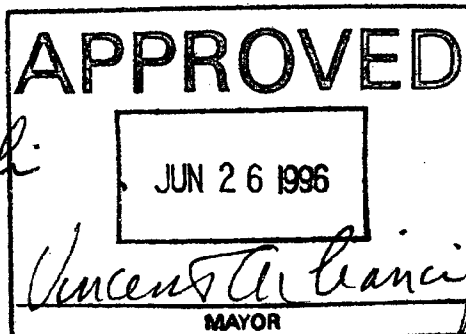
