RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 34

Approved January 21, 1977

WHEREAS, a local disaster emergency exists within the purview of "30-15-13" of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, as amended, due to the hardship caused by the present sub-zero temperatures, which have adversely affected home heating of certain residents of our City, and

WHEREAS, in order to maintain an adequate and healthy level of residential heating, the City of Providence proposes to provide relief for such resident citizens,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that His Honor the Mayor hereby declares that a local disaster emergency does exist, and should be continued for a definite emergency period, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council does hereby consent to such continuation of an emergency period, but not beyond February 8, 1977, at 9:00 o'clock P.M. (E.S.T.), unless so ordained by the City Council.
