RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 342

Approved July 17, 1989

RESOLVED, DECREED AND ORDERED, That the created Right-of-Way of the intersection of Hartford and Manton Avenues in the City of Providence, County of Providence, State of Rhode Island be received as a Public Highway and to be named at a later date under the provisions of Chapter 987, Public Laws 1913:

Beginning at the northeasterly corner of the herein described parcel on the southwesterly street line of said Manton Avenue:

thence running southeasterly along the southwesterly street line of said Manton Avenue for a distance of sixty-six and sixty-eight hundredths feet (66.68') to an angle;

thence turning an interior angle of $129^{\circ}-58'-36''$ and running southwesterly along the street line of said Manton Avenue for a distance of ten and one hundredth feet (10.01') to an angle point on the northerly street line of Hartford Avenue;

thence turning an interior angle of $128^{\circ}-33'-24''$ and running westerly along the northerly street line of said Hartford Avenue for a distance of seventy-one and sixty-eight hundredths feet (71.68') to a point

thence turning and running easterly, northerly and northwesterly along an arc of a curve having a radius of sixty-five and no hundredths feet (65.00'), a central angle of $85^{\circ}-10'-05''$ for an arc distance of ninety-six and sixty-two hundredths feet (96.62') to a point on the southwesterly street line projected of Manton Avenue;

thence turning and running northwesterly along the southwesterly projected street line of said Manton Avenue for a distance of fourteen and ninety-five hundredths feet (14.95') to a corner;

thence turning an interior angle of $59^{\circ}-38'-17''$ and running easterly for a distance of three and eight hundredths feet (3.08') to the point of beginning.

Said last described line forms an interior angle of $120^{\circ}-10'-04''$ with the first described line.

Said parcel contains 1418 square feet.

Said parcel being a portion of Lots 7 and 8 as shown on Assessor's Plat 105.

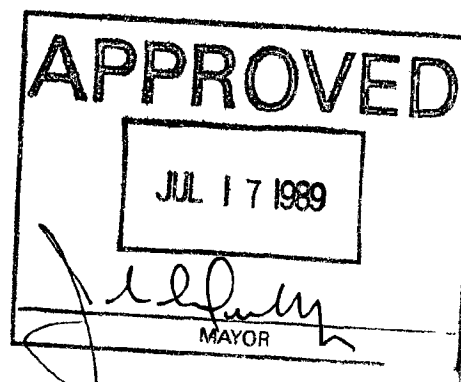

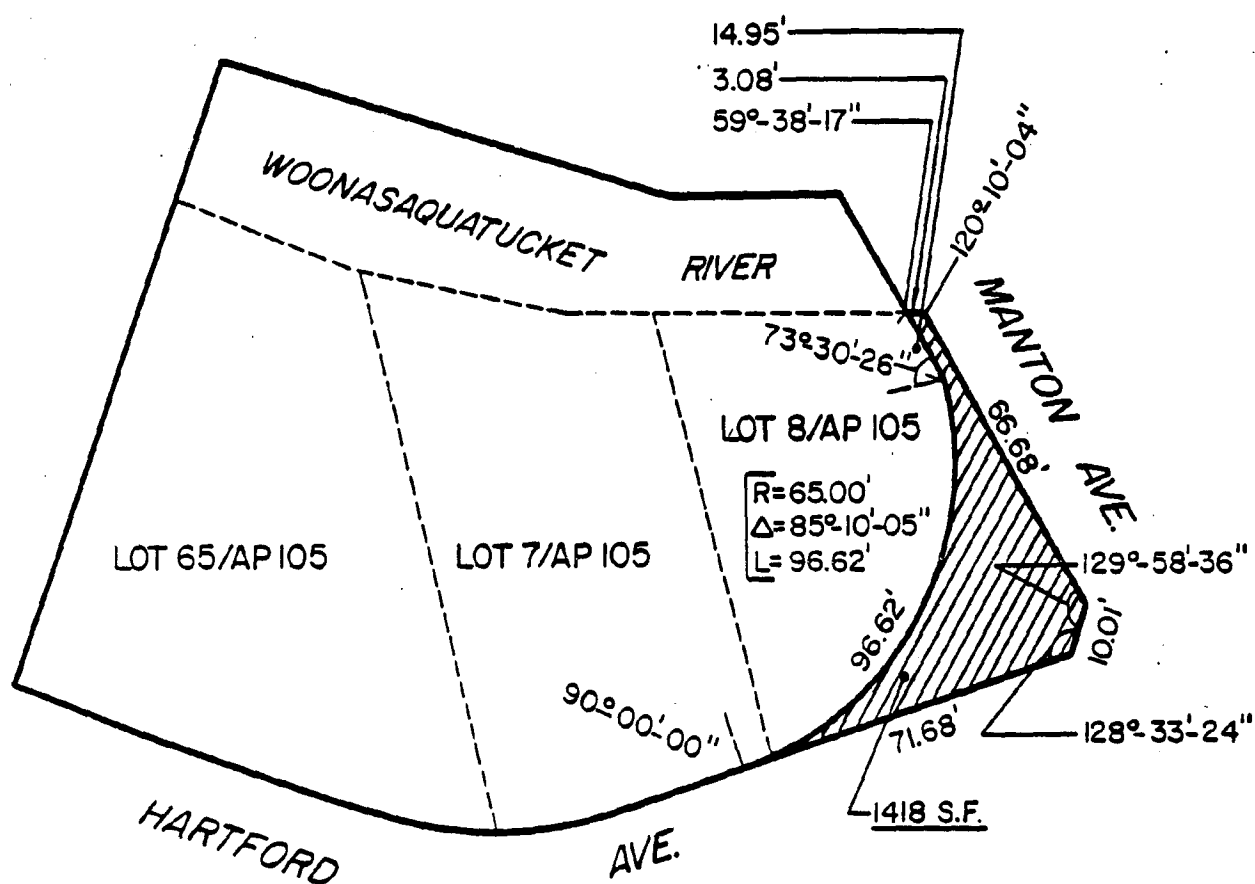
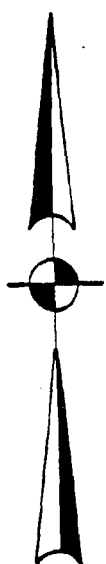
Dear Mrs. Mendonca:

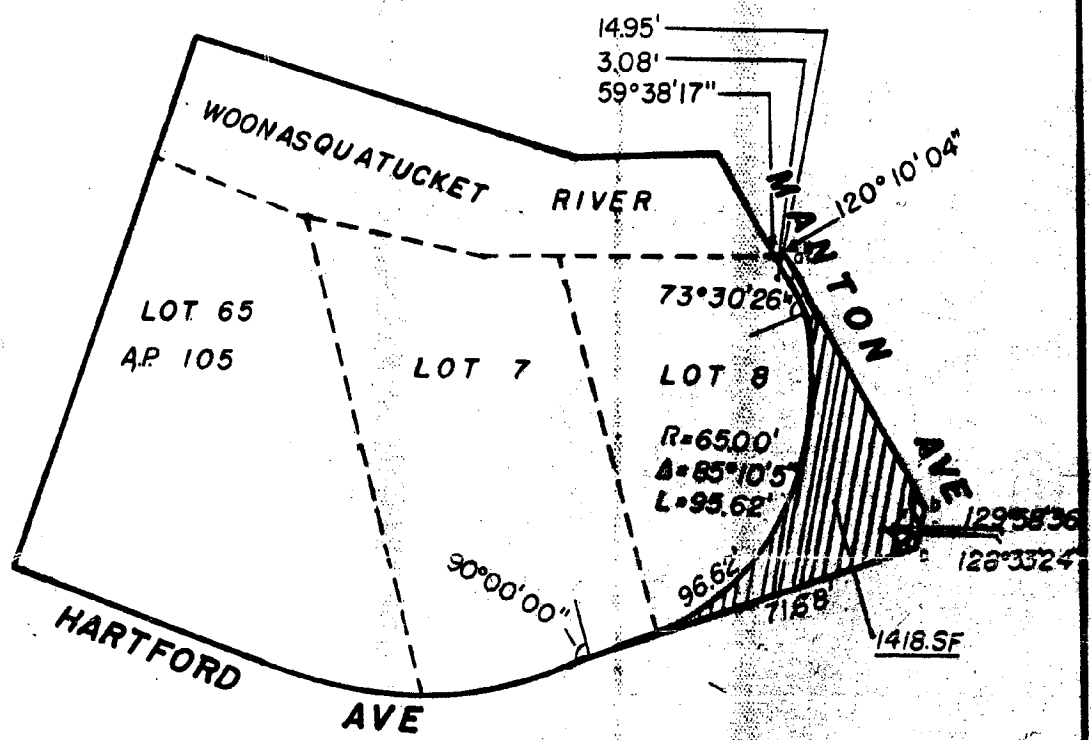

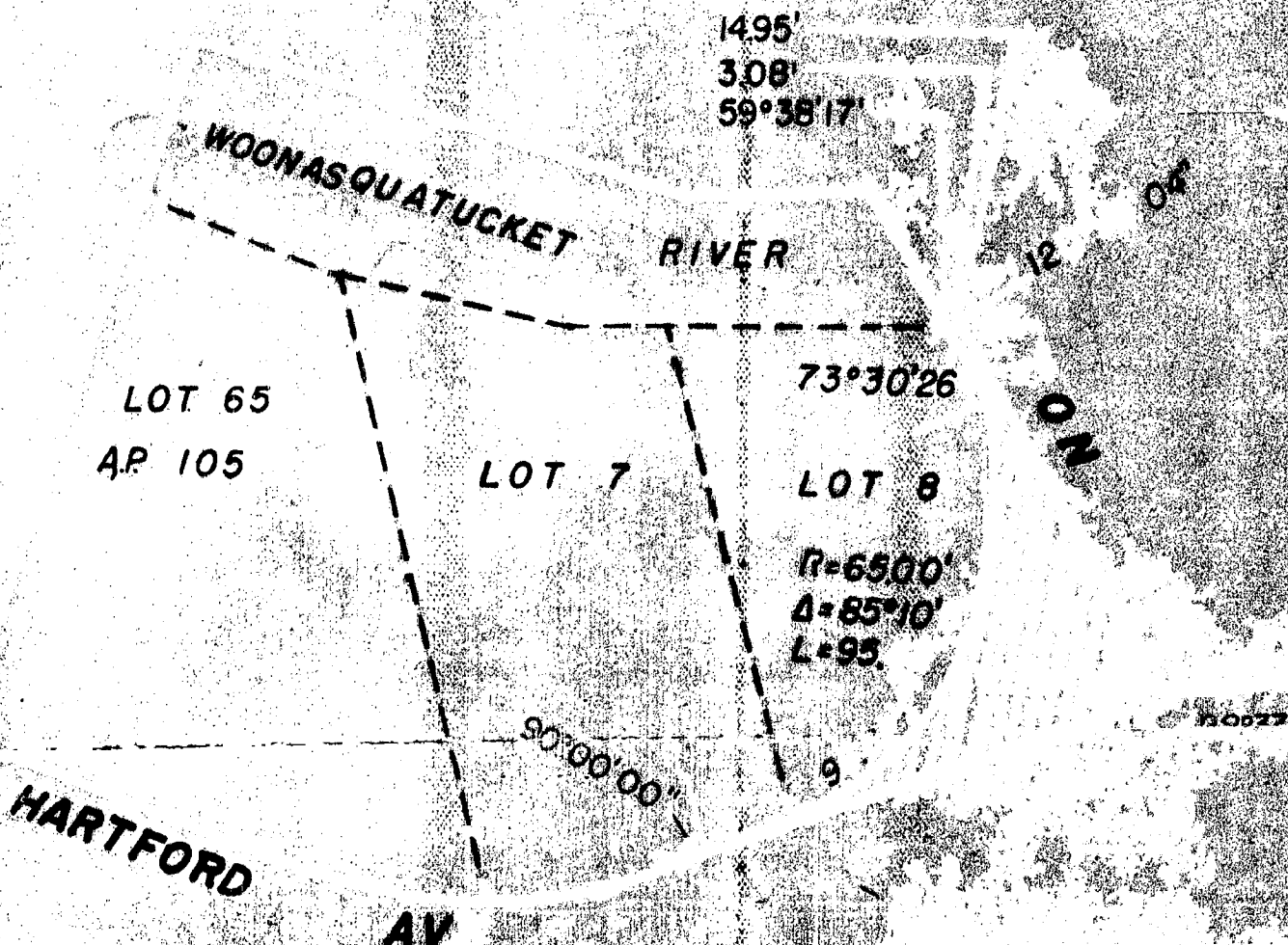

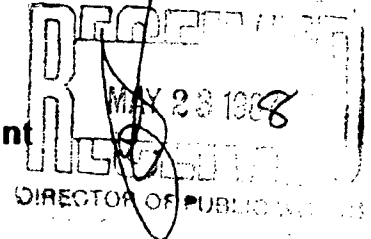

Beginning at the northeasterly corner of the herein described parcel on the southwesterly street line of said Manton Avenue:

thence running southeasterly along the southwesterly street line of said Manton Avenue for a distance of sixty-six and sixty-eight hundredths feet (66.68') to an angle;

thence turning an interior angle of $129^{\circ}-58'-36''$ and running southwesterly along the street line of said Manton Avenue for a distance of ten and one hundredth feet (10.01') to an angle point on the northerly street line of Hartford Avenue;

thence turning an interior angle of $128^{\circ}-33'-24''$ and running westerly along the northerly street line of said Hartford Avenue for a distance of seventy-one and sixty-eight hundredths feet (71.68') to a point

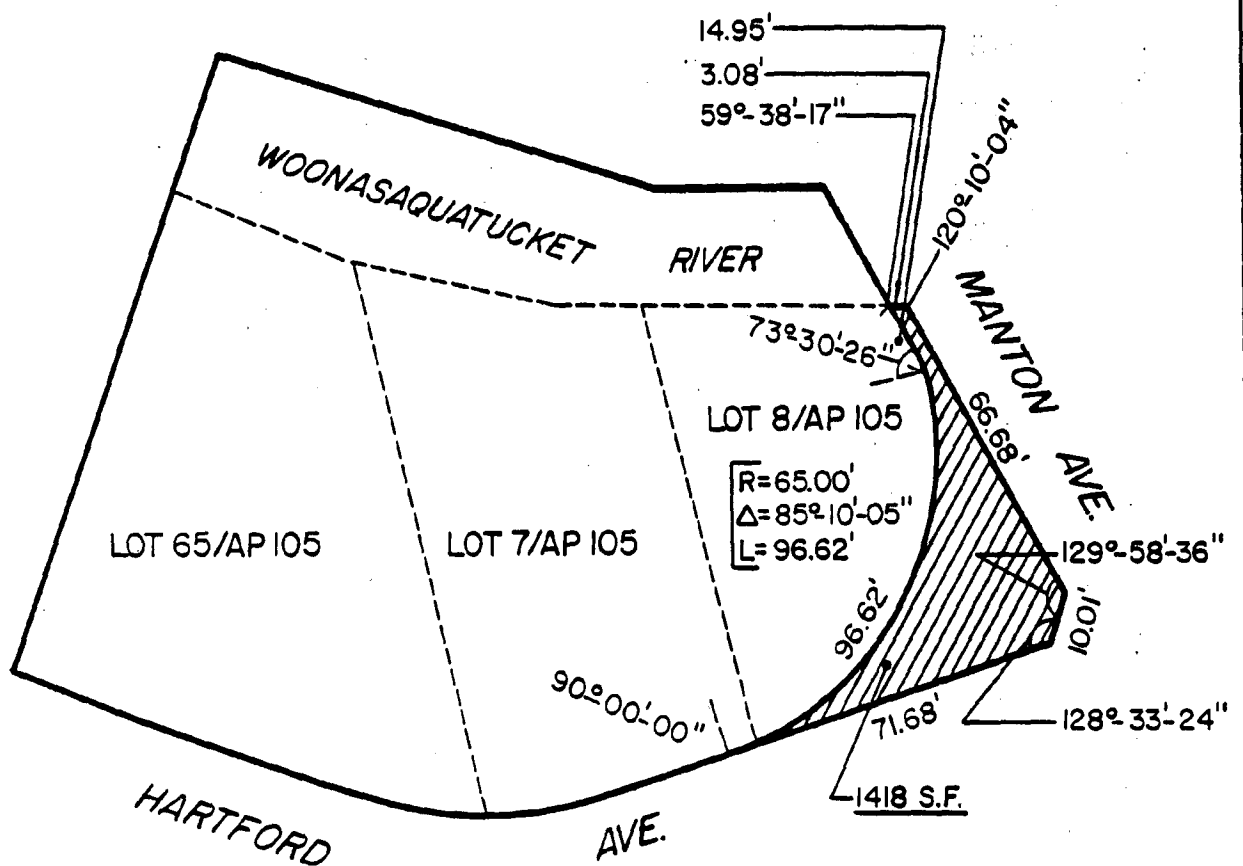
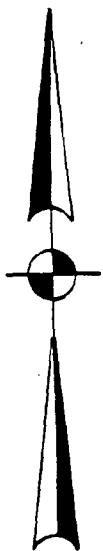

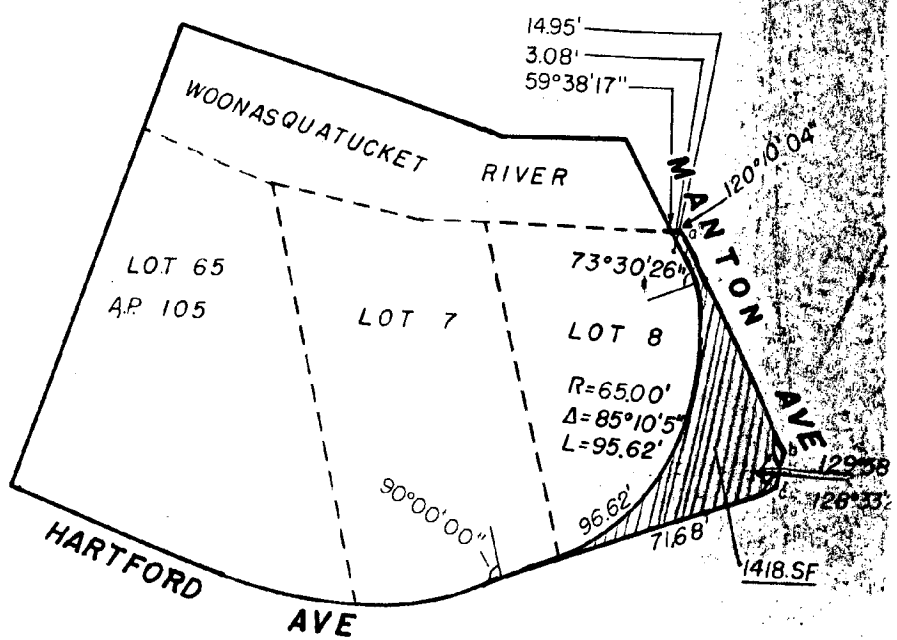
