Approved September 9, 1976

RESOLVED, that His Honor the Mayor is authorized to execute a lease with Caruso's Continental Restaurant, Providence, of a portion of Lot 322, as set out and delineated on City Assessor's Plat 62, and on accompanying Plan entitled, "Providence, R.I., P. Dept. - Engineering Office - City Property Section, Plan No. 063979, Date, August 27, 1976, at an annual fee of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars, for a term of five (5) years, with an option to renew for an additional period of five (5) years, at a fee to be negotiated for the additional period, and

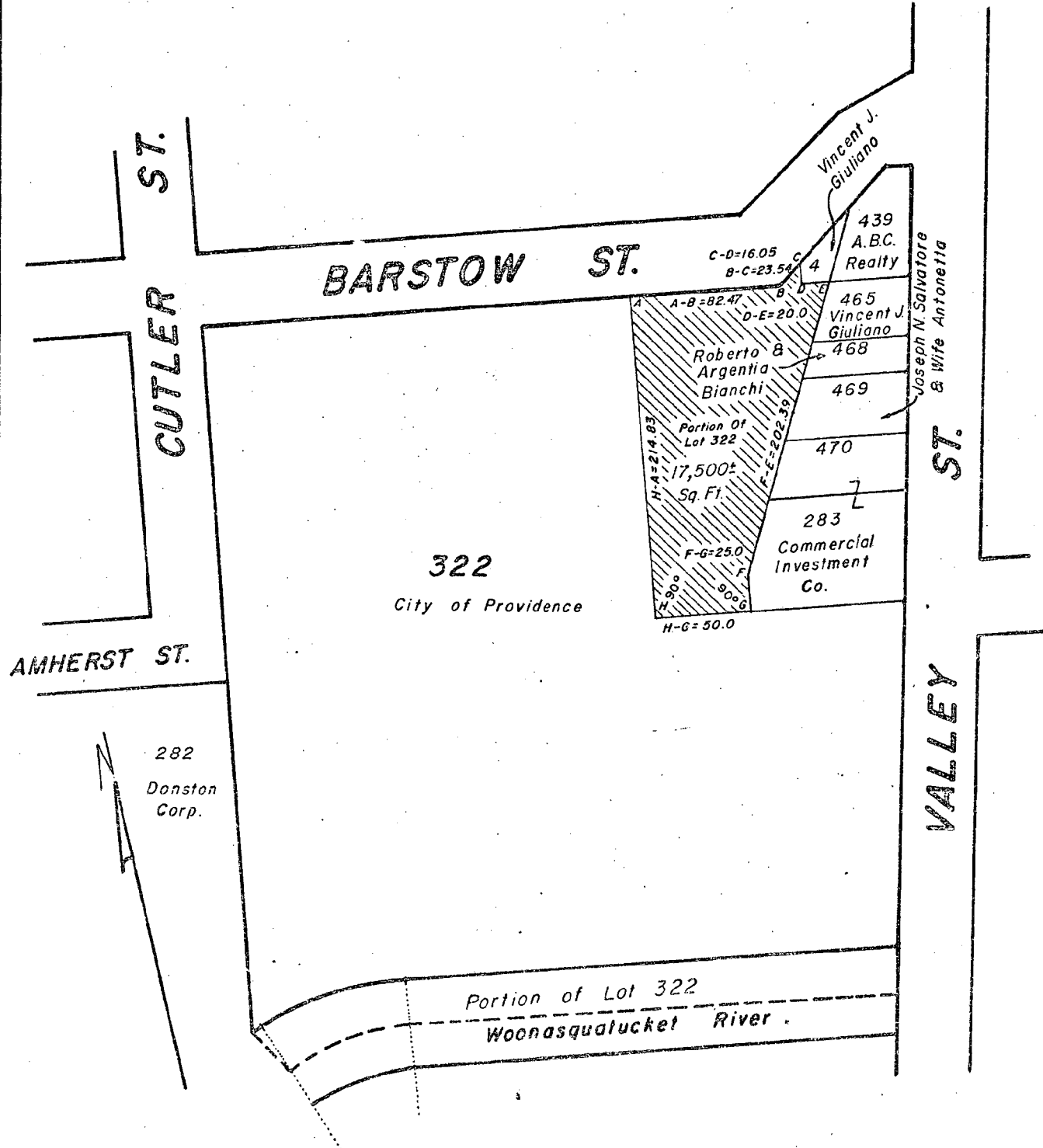
