No. 1 AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF SECTIONS 10
AND 11 OF CHAPTER 30 OF THE ORDINANCES OF 1914.

Approved January 6, 1969

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Loitering and Loafing

No person shall stand on any footwalk, sidewalk, parking lot, doorstep or in any doorway in this city as to obstruct a free passage for foot passengers; or to hinder, delay, disturb or annoy passers-by or persons residing or doing business in the vicinity thereof.

Any person obstructing any footwalk, sidewalk, parking lot, step or doorway shall move immediately when requested to do so by a police officer.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this section shall be fined not exceeding twenty dollars, or imprisoned for not more than ten days.

No. 2 AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF SECTION 1 OF
CHAPTER 1122 OF THE ORDINANCES OF 1942.

Approved January 6, 1969

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Noise--Unnecessary, annoying, etc., noises prohibited

It is hereby declared to be a nuisance and it shall be unlawful for any person to make, cause or suffer or permit to be made or caused upon any premises owned, occupied or controlled by him, or upon any public street, alley or thoroughfare in the city unnecessary noises or sounds by means of the human voice, or by any other means or methods which are physically annoying to persons, or which are so harsh, or so prolonged or unnatural, or unusual in their use, time and place as to occasion physical discomfort, or which are injurious to the lives, health, peace and comfort of the inhabitants of the city.

Dear Mayor Doorley:

Reference is made to the bridge across the intersection of Point and Eddy Streets which is presently being used in the operations of Davol Rubber Company, now known as Davol Inc. Permission to erect and maintain this bridge was granted by the City of Providence pursuant to resolution of the City Council dated October 6, 1964.

Davol Inc., a Rhode Island corporation, has agreed to sell all its assets and properties to this Company or to a wholly-owned subsidiary, Davol Inc., a Delaware corporation. Inasmuch as the bridge is essential to continued economic operation of the properties, International Paper Company desires the right to continue to use the bridge. Accordingly it is respectfully requested that the City of Providence grant to International Paper Company or its wholly-owned subsidiary the right to maintain and use the bridge in the operation of the properties in the same manner as heretofore.
