WHEREAS, the General Assembly established the Metropolitan Parks Commission; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Providence as capitol city of the state has numerous parks and recreational areas used by citizens of the state who reside in cities and towns other than the City of Providence; and,

WHEREAS, the cost to operate and maintain these park areas has become an increasing burden on the taxpayers of the city; and,

WHEREAS, many of these parks are increasingly used by citizens from other cities and towns in the state. Now, therefore be it

RESOLVED by the General Assembly of the State of Rhode Island more over that:

The Director of the Department of Environmental Management meet with the city's Superintendent of Public Parks to review, assess, and implement legislation, as it relates to various city parks and recreational areas.
