In reference to the resolution requesting the tree removal at 25 Geneva Street, it was checked out on December 19th, 1974.

My findings revealed the tree in question is a large swamp red maple with a large cavity in it's main leader branch. If this branch were to break away from the main tree trunks, it could cause much damage to a house located adjacent to the tree.


On December 19th the tree mentioned above was tagged for removal. This tree request has been placed on a preference list and should be down within thirty days.

The next request involving 78 Andem Street is not for a tree removal, but to have a tree trimmed.

A large tree at the rear of 78 Andem Street, which is also located at the end of Atkins Street is in need of trimming.

The work order has been made out and the actual trim work will take place within the next two weeks.
