

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, The Zoning Commission, the City Plan Commission, and the Department of Planning and Development have been working for some time on a revised Zoning Ordinance for the City of Providence, and


WHEREAS, This revised Zoning Ordinance will be a blueprint for the development of our City for future generations, and


WHEREAS, This revised Ordinance is to be submitted to the City Council in the very near future, and

WHEREAS, It is preferable to have development conform to the new Zoning Ordinance and avoid situations in which developers rush to obtain permits under the existing 1951 Zoning Ordinance,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Director of the Department of Inspection and Standards is directed to place a Moratorium on the issuance of building permits for new construction in the Reservoir Triangle Neighborhood as that neighborhood is defined on the official neighborhood maps of the City as attached hereto, pending the adoption of a new zoning Ordinance by the City Council, or for 180 days, whichever comes first.
