Over a month ago, I am writing to give you the house at 432-434 Prairie Avenue (plat 48 is presently rehabilitating and the lot at 55-48 lot 601) on which we will soon begin construction of a family home. Each of these properties will be owned by Housing Corporation, a new nonprofit organization which will establish both a limited equity cooperative and a trust. This model will ensure that families who are unable to become homeowners can do so and the properties will remain in the hands of low-moderate income families in perpetuity.

As discussed earlier, we would greatly appreciate your introduction of a resolution to the City Council waiving the board up liens and redeeming the property taxes to guarantee that we produce the best possible housing at the best possible price. The amounts in question are below:

55 Harriet Street (plat 48 lot 601)

Amount due to redeem property taxes: \$ 2,478.97

432 -434 Prarie Ave. (plat 48 lot 632)

Amount due to redemm property taxes	\$ 833.82
Board up liens	<u>485.78</u>
Total	\$ 1,319.60
