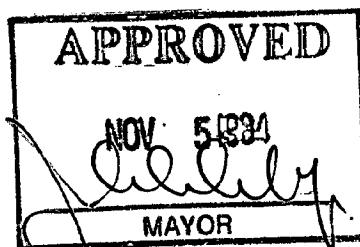
Approved November 15, 1984

This resolution is adopted pursuant to the application of the Providence Human Relations Commission made by letter of September 25, 1984.


