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YEARLY WORK REPORT, 1978

PERSONNEL & EQUIPMENT

During, 1978 the Forestry Division work force included eleven (11) full-time city employees and ten (10) full-time CETA employees to perform daily work functions. These full-time positions are broken down into the following job classifications:

The number of employees and job classifications have not changed since the last annual report 1977 was written.

The quipment assigned to the Forestry Division personnel consist of two (2) skyworkers, two (2) stake body dump trucks, one (1) pick-up truck and one (1) stationwagon. One (1) small dump truck, determined by public works mechanics to be beyond repair, was junked as a source of future parts. Lastly, one (1) winch truck under repair by the parks mechanic staff since November, 1977, was unavailable for daily use during 1978.

EQUIPMENT PURCHASES

In August, 1978, Forestry Division purchased three (3) 1979 stake body dump trucks from Notarantonio Trucking, Inc. of No. Providence, the lowest competitive bidder for these items. The total cost for these three vehicles was \$30,000.00. The acquisition of this equipment was made possible by encumbering \$10,000 from the divisions capital outlay account and \$20,000 from its' personal services (199) account. Four mobile radio units were also purchased to provide an effective communication



system between Forestry city forces. Since the inception of this "beeper" network of communication, Forestry operations have run much more efficiently than at any time in the past. The purchase price of these four units and their yearly service charge came to \$1,288.00.

WORK REPORT

There were 256 potential work days during January 1-December 31, 1978. The number of actual work days, defined as those days in which Forestry personnel actually engaged in work related operations, totaled 219. This figure represents a 13 day increase over year 1977. The number of potential work days lost in 1978 were 37. These non-working days occurred as a result of either inclement weather or other unmitigating circumstances.

Absenteeism due either to sickness or other personal matters amounted to a loss of 319 men work days. There was also a loss of 75 men work days from job related injuries. Down-time for equipment breakdowns among the entire Forestry mobiles totaled 225 days. Although the equipment breakdowns were up slightly over last year, the absenteeism rate dropped off dramatically in 1978 (579 to 319). A substantial amount of overtime hrs. (2,010.50) occurred in 1978. Ninety-percent of this overtime expenditure was a result of the ice-storm that caused immeasurable damage to urban trees last January, 1978.

TREE REMOVAL

There were approximately 700 trees removed from public property under the direction of the Forestry staff in 1978. Of this total, 528 trees were felled by city forces and the remainder (172) by private contractor. The number of trees removed by city forces translated into the disposal of 5,221 diameter inches, an increase of 1,800 inches from 1977 (170 more trees). The average size (DBH) and cost of a tree removed by city forces was 12.4" and \$55.00, respectively.

The Bartlett Tree Expert, Inc. was responsible for causing the removal of 122 public trees at a cost of \$15,360. These removals were paid with an allocation of funds made available by the Mayor's Office of Community Development for city wide tree beautification. The average cost of these tree removals was \$145.00.

Approximately 50 street trees were also removed by a subcontractor of Lynch Construction Inc., the general contractor for roadway improvements under the Economic Development Grant



received by Providence last fall, 1977.

As of December 31, 1978, there was an outstanding backlog of 102 public trees marked for removal.

STUMP REMOVALS:

Approximately 385 stumps were removed on public property by city and private forces during 1978. The city forces were responsible for causing the removal of about 170 stumps at an average cost of \$44.00 each. Bartlett Tree Experts removed 135 stumps at a cost of \$50.00 each, while Lynch sub-contractors removed 35 stumps city wide. These stumps removed by private contractors were accomplished with federal funds.

Since there were many more trees removed than stumps in 1978, the outstanding backlog has grown considerably. Presently the stump backlog totals about 255.

TREE PRUNING

Approximately 941 city trees received some type of cosmetic or safety pruning by private contractors during 1978. This private work was conducted with \$40,000. funded by Mayor's Office of Community Development. Bartlett Tree Expert, Inc. and R. J. Francis were the firms awarded the tree work through competitive bidding. The majority of this work was directed toward repairing many street trees damaged by last winters' severe ice storm.

Forestry personnel performed maintenance pruning on about 1307 street trees in 1978. Most of this work was done in response to citizens request for public assistance. Hopkins Square, Blackstone Boulevard, Verrazano Park and Lippit Park trees also received cosmetic attention by Forestry work crews.

A back log of approximately 275 work orders for street tree trimming still remains outstanding as of Decemver 31, 1978.

SUMMARY

The Forestry Division experienced many unenviable tasks and challenges during 1978. No sooner had staff members completed a street tree survey, when Providence was devastated by one of the worst ice-storms in the city's history in late January. Besides personal hardship and property loss, no where were the destructive forces of this storm more evident than in the damage incurred by the urban tree stock. Fallen trees, dangerous, broken limbs and debris strewn streets was a common sight throughout the city immediately following the storm. The tree damage wreaked



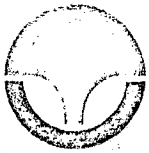
by the storm would later be estimated in the vicinity of \$3.5 million dollars.

The obvious task facing Forestry of cleaning and making streets safe for emergency vehicles and pedestrians was no doubt easier said than done. The magnitude and scope of the destruction to trees city wide made it virtually impossible for Forestry crews to cope with the enormous clean-up operations. To undertake such an endeavor it became necessary to seek outside assistance to bolster city forces and equipment. Three different private tree service contractors were therefore hired under emergency status. The bills incurred by Forestry as a result of storm work performed by private contractors totalled \$37,000. As of December 1, 1978, all but \$14,000 of these billings for services rendered by contractors during the storm have been paid. The repair work and debris clean up by forestry crews continued until late May, when, for the first time in months, regular maintenance work was once again assigned on a daily basis.

In mid February, 1978 the Mayor's Office of Community Development (M. O. C. D.) had allocated to Forestry approximately \$200,000. and \$75,000 for tree planting and tree maintenance work, respectively. Specification documents were prepared by Forestry for street and park tree planting, tree removal and pruning contracts. The tree removal and tree pruning contracts were designed primarily for further storm repair work. It must be mentioned that since M. O. C. D. funded the tree removal contract, Forestry did not have to use any money from it's personal services account (Line item 199) for removals. This "extra money" in the Forestry budget paved the way for the purchase of three (3) 1979 stake body dump trucks later in the year.

During the summer months, besides monitoring an ongoing tree planting program and pruning project, Forestry administrative personnel were busy preparing for what was soon to be the single largest shade tree planting project in the city's history. This project which would eventually lead to the planting of over 1900 public trees was federally funded by an Economic Development grant. Many new tree varieties were introduced to the urban streetscape via this project. Most noteworthy among these were massplanting of the "Callery" and "Bradford" Pear, Euclora Linden, "Marshall's Seedless" Ash and "Green Mountain" Sugar Maples. The superior quality of these trees which came from reputable nursery's located on Long Island, N. Y. and New Jersey, was exceeded only by the fine workmanship displayed by the private planting crews.

Forestry work crews were quite productive despite the paucity of good equipment and one-third of the year being devoted



to storm related emergencies.

Although there are many reasons for an increase in tree removals and tree trimming work over last year, 1977, chief among these is the contribution made by C. E. T. A. employees. Many of the CETA employees were quite receptive to learning more advanced arboriculture skills required only of tree trimmers. The training of CETA employees in basic work skills has resulted in a better distribution of the work load than in previous years. The end product of their motivations has been a more efficient and productive work force.

From an administrative point of view, Forestry would have been incapable to monitor with success any of these various projects without a competent staff to direct and oversee projects. To this end, responsibility was delegated among key personnel. Mr. Ralph Sabetta, a CETA employee with a master's degree in horticulture from U. R. I., was instrumental in organizing and coordinating the tree planting projects as well as carrying out daily administrative duties in Forestry. Inspection duties related to the federal projects and citizen requests for services were assigned to John Palumbo and James Bucci, city workers who heretofore were classified as an equipment operator and tree trimmer, respectively. Finally, the unenviable tasks of preparing the manuscripts, documents and daily paperwork for these projects was Mrs. Muriel Hodge, Forestry's most dependable secretary.

In conclusion, although the year commenced with a storm that caused immeasurable damage to the street scape, it ended with the completion of federally funded projects that contributed to the planting of over 2,900 public trees. It is hoped that city officials will view this achievement in 1978 as a positive step toward the revitalization of Providence, and will continue to support a program dedicated to this end.

TREE PLANTING

During 1978 the municipality of Providence had undertaken probably the largest shade tree planting project in the city's history. There were approximately 2,600 new trees planted on public property city wide by December, 1978 as a result of this project. The funding for tree planting was obtained through two federal agencies, the Economic Development Administration (EDA) and Health Education & Welfare Administration (Community Development Act).

On September 8, 1977, Providence was awarded a \$6.6 million grant from the E. D. A. to finance reconstruction work on 19 major streets throughout the city. Of the original allocation \$400,000 was set aside for street tree beautification along those thoroughfares to receive roadway improvements.

As of December, 1978 approximately 1,900 trees were planted by Major Contracting, Inc. a private contractor, on the following streets: Admiral, Broad, Charles, Cranston, Empire, Mountain, Plainfield, Silver Spring, Valley, West Exchange, Washington, Westminster, Weybosset and Douglas Avenues.

Also, under this project the Hartford, Valley, Mt. Pleasant. West End and Elmhurst neighborhoods, severely devastated by Dutch Elm Blight and past neglect, were chosen for more concentrated street by street tree planting.

The Forestry Division also received approximately \$170,000 from the Mayor's Office of Community Development for additional tree planting. These funds were basically used to replace dead trees originally planted in 1977 as well as to finance new tree planting. Approximately 1,071 trees were planted along streets and parks by Alpine Tree Service, a private contractor, under this program. Streets that received new tree plantings included Atwells, Doyle and Whitford Avenues, Public, Hawkins, Eaton, Hamilton, Niagara, Brook and Sessions Streets. These funds were also used to plant trees city wide on a property owner request basis. Priority was given to those home owners whose street tree had been removed within the past three years by the city.
