AMENDMENT TO COOPERATION AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, entered into this day
of , 1957, by and between THE HOUSING AUTHORITY
OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, RHODE ISLAND, (herein called the
"Local Authority"), and the CITY OF PROVIDENCE, Rhode Island,
(herein called the "Municipality");

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, a certain Cooperation Agreement, dated January
3, 1950, has been entered into between the Local Authority and
the Municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Local Authority and the Municipality deem it
desirable to amend the Cooperation Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Local Authority and the Municipality
agree as follows:

1. That the following section numbered 10 be added to
the Cooperation Agreement:

"10. In addition to the Payments in Lieu of Taxes and
in further consideration for the public services and facilities
furnished and to be furnished in respect to any Project for
which no annual contributions contract had been entered into
prior to August 2, 1954, between the Local Authority and the
Public Housing Administration;

(1) After payment in full of all obligations of the Local
Authority in connection with such Project for which any annual
contributions are pledged and until the total amount of annual
contributions paid by the PHA in respect to such Project has been
repaid, (a) all receipts in connection with such Project in ex-
cess of expenditures necessary for the management, operation,
maintenance, or financing, and for reasonable reserves therefor,
shall be paid annually to the PHA and to the Municipality on
behalf of the local public bodies which have contributed to such

Project in the form of tax exemption or otherwise, in proportion to the aggregate contribution which the PHA and such local public bodies have made to such project, and (b) no debt in respect to such project, except for necessary expenditures for such Project, shall be incurred by the Local Authority;

(2) If, at any time, such Project or any part thereof is sold, such sale shall be to the highest responsible bidder after advertising, or at fair market value as approved by the PHA, and the proceeds of such sale together with any reserves, after application to any outstanding debt of the Local Authority in respect to such Project, shall be paid to the PHA and local public bodies as provided in clause 1(a) of this Section 10: Provided, That the amounts to be paid to the PHA and the local public bodies shall not exceed their respective total contribution to such Project;

(3) The Municipality shall distribute the payments made to it pursuant to clauses (1) and (2) of this Section 10 among the local public bodies (including the Municipality) in proportion to their respective aggregate contributions to such Project."

2. In all other respects, the Cooperation Agreement dated shall remain in full force and effect.
