LABORER II - HURRICANE DAM

CLASS TITLE: Laborer II - Hurricane Dam

CLASS DEFINITION: Performs manual work in doing a variety of semi-skilled tasks; and keeping watch to safeguard property against damage or loss; and related work as required.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF WORK: Work involves responsibility for following an established routine in making rounds and guarding against any possibility of damage or loss of property. Work assignments are received in detail. Routine work is performed pursuant to general instructions but detailed assignments are made for special tasks. Persons of this class may occasionally be assigned to carry out specific tasks.

ILLUSTRATIVE EXAMPLES OF WORK: Makes regular rounds inside or outside of buildings, watches for prowlers, fires or other danger of loss or damage of property. Makes routine reports and special reports of any disturbances or suspicious circumstances. May be required to do incidental cleaning work in addition to making watch rounds. Occasionally will act in carrying out specific tasks such as removing snow.

DESIRABLE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS AND ABILITIES: Ability to follow a prescribed routine of making rounds. Physical ability to make both inside and outside watch rounds under various conditions. Physical ability to apprehend prowlers, put out small fires, and do other required manual tasks. Alertness and good judgment in noticing and reporting anything out of the ordinary which might indicate a danger of loss or damage to property. Ability to perform semi-skilled manual tasks without close supervision. Ability to understand and carry out oral and written instructions and to keep routine records.

QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED FOR APPOINTMENT: Sufficient training to insure ability to understand oral instruction, and keep simple records. Considerable experience in performing manual labor and using hand tools.
