RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 323

Approved May 20, 1974

RESOLVED, that the Providence City Council and the Honorable Mayor of the City of Providence express their sympathy to the families, relatives, and friends of the innocent and unarmed high school children recently killed in a barbaric and hideous manner in the State of Israel, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Providence City Council condemn the vicious killers, their sponsors, backers, and supporters, for their inhuman, cowardly, and unprincipled deeds in the slaughtering of these innocents, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the families, friends, and supporters, including the responsible and religious leaders of Israel, be encouraged to redouble their efforts and prayers in their historic fight for freedom, independence, and secure boundaries, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Leaders of the United Nations; Syria, Lebanon, and Egypt, and all Nations and groups, to condemn, expel, and jail the leaders and groups that were responsible for this type of activity, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this Resolution be sent to said leaders, the President of the United States, and the Rhode Island Congress and Delegation.
