NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Director of Public Works be and he hereby is requested to cause ^{Two} Ten Foot ^{Rmm} Sections of Concrete Jersey Barrier to be constructed along the curblineline of 36-38 Carter Street.
