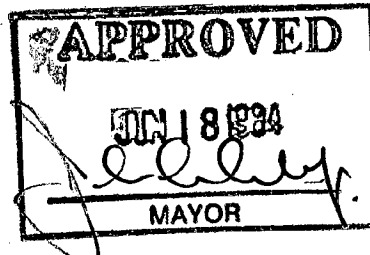

CERTAIN BUILDINGS LOCATED ON
WESTMINSTER STREET IN THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE

TO THE HONORABLE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE:

FLEET NATIONAL BANK, a national banking association ("Fleet"), respectfully represents:

FIRST: Fleet, together with several partners, is presently erecting a new building located on Westminster Street and Kennedy Plaza in the City of Providence. Fleet will be the principal tenant of such building, to be known as "Fleet Center".

SECOND: Fleet is the owner of certain premises located at 100 Westminster Street which premises are occupied by the Trust and Investment Division of Fleet. The designation "100 Westminster Street" is closely identified with the activities of, and is promoted by, said Trust and Investment Division.

THIRD: Fleet proposes to relocate such Trust and Investment Division to Fleet Center upon completion of Fleet Center and in connection with such relocation desires to retain the identification of the Trust and Investment Division with "100 Westminster Street".

WHEREFORE, Fleet petitions this Honorable City Council
as follows:

1. That the Westminster Street address of Fleet Center be numbered and identified as "100 Westminster Street", such numbering and identification to become effective as of 1 December, 1984.

2. That, contemporaneously with the above numbering, the premises currently numbered and identified as 100 Westminster Street be renumbered "90 Westminster Street".




Dear Ms. Mendonca:

Article I. In General

Sec. 23-1. Names of streets.

The several streets in the city shall continue to be called and known by the names heretofore given to them unless and until they are altered by the city council. (Ord. 1914, ch. 30, § 1; Rev. Ords. 1946, ch. 33, § 10)

Sec. 23-2. Numbering; renumbering of streets, buildings.

The city council may order the buildings on any street to be numbered or may order any street to be renumbered, and the director of public works shall then require the number designated for each building to be affixed thereto or inscribed thereon. Any owner or occupant of a building who, for more than fifteen (15) days after notice from the director of public works, neglects or refuses to affix to or inscribe on such building the street number lawfully designated therefor, or who affixes or causes to be affixed to such building, or inscribes or causes to be inscribed thereon, or retain thereon, for more than fifteen (15) days after notice from the director of public works, a street number other

than the one so designated, shall be deemed guilty of a violation of this section punishable as provided in section 1-10. (Ord. 1914, ch. 30, § 2; Rev. Ords. 1946, ch. 33, § 11)

Sec. 23-3. Obstructing streets leading to, adjoining harbor or river.

No person shall suffer or permit any wood, lumber, merchandise or other thing whatever to him belonging, or under his care or control, to be and remain in any street or highway leading to or adjoining the waters of the harbor or river, nor on any public land adjoining said harbor or river, any longer time than is necessary to land the same from or put the same on board any boat or vessel, and in no case to exceed twenty-four (24) hours. (Ord. 1914, ch. 30, § 30; Rev. Ords. 1946, ch. 33, § 40)

Sec. 23-4. Erection of fences and buildings on building lines; encroachments.

Whenever the director of public works or any person about to erect any fence or building on any line of any street or highway, shall request the city council to examine into, ascertain and show to such director of public works or person so requesting, the line of such street or highway, the city council shall ascertain and point out such line. In case any person shall erect any fence or building so as to encroach on any street or highway, the city council shall proceed in the premises as the interest of the city in its opinion may require. (Ord. 1914, ch. 30, § 5; Rev. Ords. 1946, ch. 33, § 5)

Sec. 23-5. Barbed wire fences.

No fence constructed in whole or in part of barbed wire, so-called, shall hereafter be built, erected, used or maintained upon any public street or highway of this city, or along the side thereof, or of any sidewalk forming a part thereof, nor shall any such fence be built, erected, used or maintained as


