WHEREAS, The Blackstone Boulevard Jogging Path was implemented to encourage people to walk and jog and enjoy good health, and

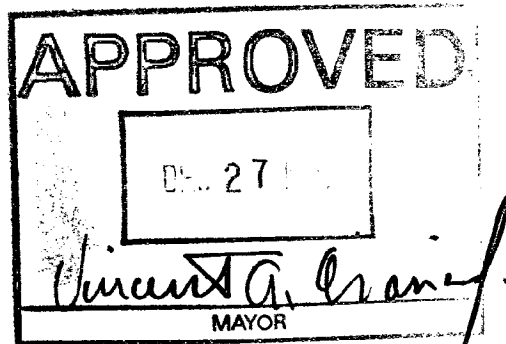
WHEREAS, The constant use of the path has caused crevices, erosion and an unevenness, so as to impair and impede people from walking without falling,
