MATHEWSON STREET, (portion) from the intersection of Sabin Street running north a distance of approximately 296 feet to the intersection of West Exchange Street, be abandoned.
CARVEL STREET, from Brush Hill Road to Hill Crest Avenue, be abandoned.

WAYLAND AVENUE, (portion) from East George Street southerly 100 feet and a portion of East George Street from a point 150 feet east of the easterly line of Wayland Avenue easterly to Butler Avenue, be abandoned.

LESTER STREET, from Harrison Street to Dexter Street, grade be defined; bring to the established or defined grade at the expense of the abutting owners; curbing be set at the expense of the abutting owners; lay out as a public highway.

FAUNCE DRIVE, from approximately 490 feet westerly of Cole Avenue to Cole Avenue, main drain or common sewer be constructed.

BARBOUR DRIVE, from near Wriston Drive to Faunce Drive, main drain or common sewer be constructed.

MAXCY DRIVE, from near Faunce Drive to Barbour Drive, main drain or common sewer be constructed.

The undersigned are all taxpayers and residents of Roger Williams Avenue. We live on a street which is in a prime residential^{by} by most standards, including the high taxes assessed on our property. More and more, the residential character of the street is threatened by increasing through traffic. This traffic backs up solidly during rush hours, making it almost impossible for residents to get out of their own driveways. Some of us recently spoke to one of our councilmen about re-routing some of this heavy traffic and were told it was impossible.

There is one alleviation, however, that seems to us to be quite feasible, and that is the banning of heavy through trucks that rumble through the street at all hours of the night, shaking the houses and breaking our rest.

Therefore, we respectfully petition the city council to have heavy trucking^{AND BUSES} banned on Roger Williams Avenue between the hours of 8 p.m. and 7 a.m. as it is now on Public Street, a considerably less residential area than our street.
