# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

*No. 357*

**EFFECTIVE July 28, 2014**

WHEREAS, On September 9, 2014, the City of Providence will hold a primary election;  
and

WHEREAS, There are approximately 104,000 registered voters in the City of Providence  
who are presently eligible to participate in the primary on September 9, 2014; and

WHEREAS, 80 polling places will be open for the September 9, 2014 primary in the City  
of Providence; and



WHEREAS, During previous elections, many polling places in the City of Providence  
have experienced high voter volume, which resulted in long wait times and public safety  
concerns.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the City Council hereby requests the  
Providence Police Department and the Rhode Island State Police to deploy officers to every  
polling place as determined necessary in the City of Providence on election day for the purpose  
of public safety and to maintain law and order.


