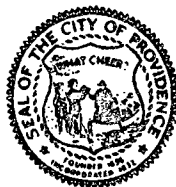

Dear Rose:

Please consider this a disclosure to the City Council pursuant to Providence Home Rule Charter Section 1206(d) of a potential conflict of interest. The Rhode Island Conflict of Interest Commission, pursuant to a request for an advisory opinion which I submitted, has indicated that it would be a conflict of interest for me to vote on the pending institutional zoning ordinance. The reason for the conflict arises out of the fact that another attorney in the law firm of which I am a partner has represented at least one and perhaps two institutions in connection with development of the proposed ordinance.

Because I have abstained from voting on the ordinance, I am not certain whether the foregoing is within Section 1206(d). However, out of an abundance of caution, I am filing this disclosure statement with your office.
