COUNCIL PRESIDENT PETROSINELLI calls for Nominations for Public Administrator.




COUNCIL PRESIDENT PETROSINELLI calls for Nominations for Viewer of Fences.

SOLDIERS AND SAILORS**


COUNCIL PRESIDENT PETROSINELLI calls for Nominations for Superintendent of Burial of Deceased Soldiers and Sailors.
