

FROM PLAINFIELD ST. TO NORTH LINE OF EASTWOOD AVE

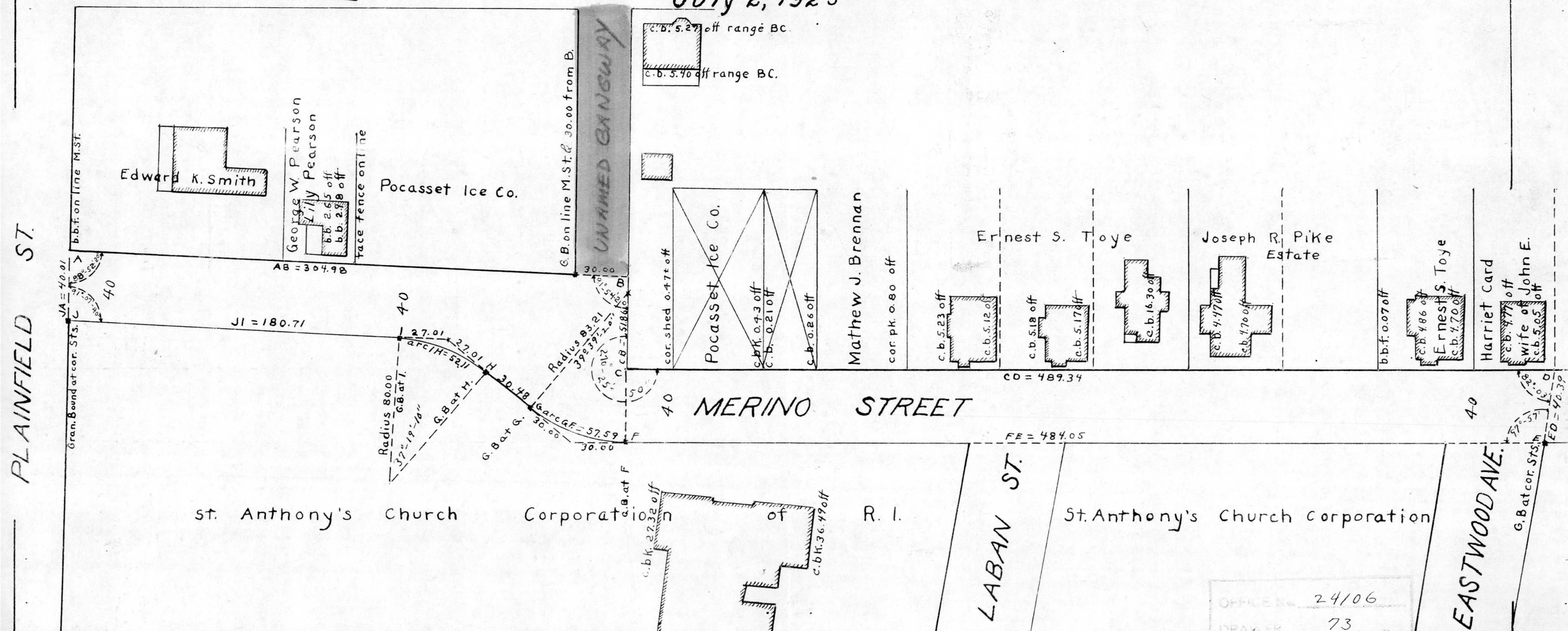

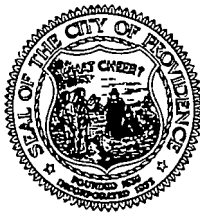
