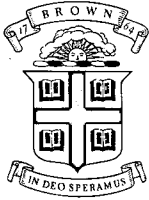

Dear Ms. Testa:

The 1993 Brown University Spring Weekend activities are slated for Thursday through Sunday, April 22nd, 23rd, 24th and 25th. I am requesting your assistance and approval for the following street closing which will assist in making the planned activities much safer due to the number of people in the area.

On Saturday, April 24, there will be a concert on the Main Green from 12:30 - 6:00 PM. This year we are requesting to be able to close down George Street between Magee and Brown Streets from 12:00 Noon until 6:00 PM, when the Concert ends. 


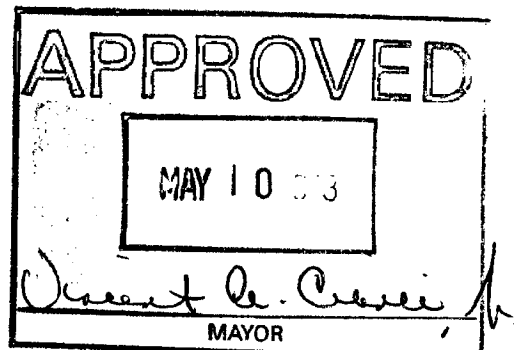
