

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 370

Approved July 10, 1973

WHEREAS, the Central Y.M.C.A., now located at 160 Broad Street in the City of Providence, has been one of the great, positive, and beneficial institutions of our community, and

WHEREAS, the said Y.M.C.A. has been a social and athletic center for persons of all races, creeds, and color, providing top leadership and encouraging sound values, and

WHEREAS, the existing building, built in 1912, is overcrowded with over 2,000 persons per day using its facilities, and

WHEREAS, the said "Y" provided one of the best and largest youth programs in our community, with no expense to the taxpayers, and

WHEREAS, the "Y", by encouraging good physical condition, health, and the preventive medicine of exercising, making it just as important, if not more, than hospitals,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that His Honor, Mayor Joseph A. Doorley, Jr., and the City Council, endorse the expansion, modernization, and improvement of the facilities of this great institution and urge wholehearted support of the current One Million Three Hundred Thousand (\$1,300,000) Dollars Capital Improvement Drive of the Greater Providence Central Y.M.C.A., and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted, by the City Clerk, to Mr. Howard Yeager, Chairman of the Board of Management of the Providence Y.M.C.A.
