
Dear Mr. Haxton:

I am writing to you relative to a resolution which was approved by the Board of Commissioners of the Providence Housing Authority at our monthly meeting held on November 20, 1973. Also, I am enclosing a copy of the resolution as approved. A copy of the Plot Plan describing the easement which is contained in the resolution has been delivered to the City Clerk's Office, by our counsel, John F. Cicilline.

This important matter of making the land available for water and sewer purposes is extremely urgent not only to the Housing Authority but also to the residents at Hartford Park. Presently, we are working with the McCann Builders, Inc. of Warwick, Rhode Island who have been designated to erect the Multi-Purpose Center at Hartford Park. 
Dear Mr. Vespia:

The Housing Authority of the City of Providence is participating in the construction of the Hartford Park Community Center on land adjacent to the Laurel Hill Avenue Playground. It is necessary to secure an easement for sewer and water connections through the Laurel Hill Avenue Playground.

The Authority would, therefore, request that the City Council grant a twenty (20) foot easement along the rear boundary line of the Laurel Hill Avenue Playground for a distance of approximately two hundred (200) feet.
