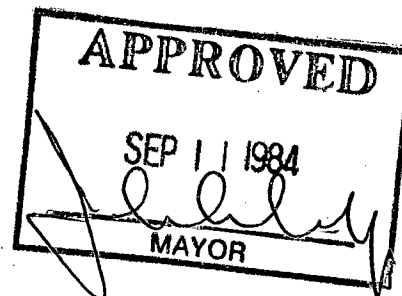

Dear Ms. Mendonca:

I write, at the suggestion of Terry Pitts, on behalf of the residents of Methyl Street. (Methyl Street is off Hope Street between Seventh and Eighth Streets.) We would like to close off the street to traffic on Saturday, September 8, for our annual Block Party. Sawhorses or signs can be left at my house, 44 Methyl Street, and I will take care of setting them up and taking them down on the 8th.

Last year when we did this, the police interrupted our Block Party and questioned our authority to have the sawhorses up. We explained we had gone through Mr. Pitts, but the matter was not fully resolved. Thus, if you can notify the police when authority to close off the street is granted, we would appreciate it.
