RE: PENDING RESOLUTIONS

REQUEST: That the Traffic Engineer is requested to cause the installation of a four-way stop control on Pleasant Valley Parkway at the intersections of Moorland Avenue and Nelson Street.

RE: PENDING RESOLUTIONS

REQUEST: That the Traffic Engineer is requested to cause the installation of a four-way STOP at the intersection of Fair Oaks Avenue and Roslyn Avenue.

DISPOSITION: Denied. This intersection does not meet the warrants for a multi-way stop control. Stop signs are not to be used for speed control. A four-way stop will be established at the intersection of Fair Oaks Avenue and Elmhurst.
