
WHEREAS, the untimely death of William A. Greene in his ⁶⁰70th year has left a void in his family, religious, ^{Rmm} Official life, and

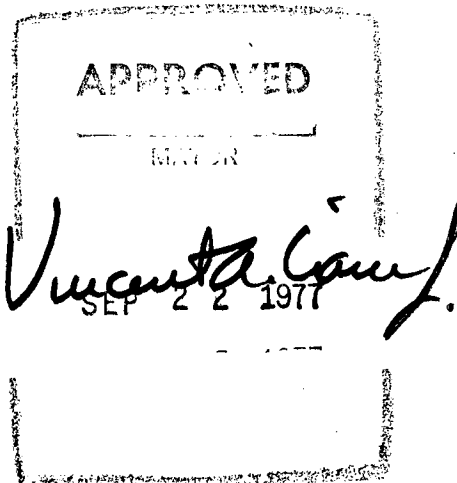


