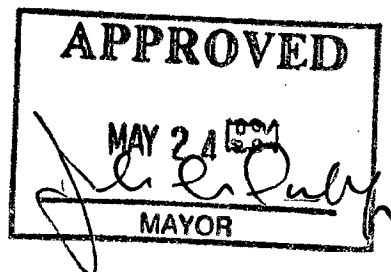
WHEREAS, In this arena Roy Brennan has emerged as a true champion of the people, and a champion of the Democratic Party,
