



RELATING TO RETIREMENT OF EMPLOYEES OF  
THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (14) of section 8 of chapter 489 of the  
2 public laws of 1923 entitled "An Act to Provide for the Retirement of  
3 the employees of the city of Providence" as amended is hereby further  
4 amended to read as follows:

5 "Sec. 8. Service Creditable.

6 \* \* \*

7 (14) Any class A or B employee employed by the city of Providence  
8 on ~~March 1, 1985~~ <sup>September 1, 1985</sup> who has previously served as an employee of any state  
9 or municipal government may prior to ~~July 30, 1985~~ <sup>October 1, 1985</sup> pay into the  
10 retirement system a contribution equal to eight (8%) percent of his  
11 compensation earnable in his first year of creditable service multi-  
12 plied by the number of years and fraction thereof in such ~~state~~ ser-  
13 vice.

1       Upon such payment, anything to the contrary notwithstanding, such  
2       amount shall become part of his accumulated contributions and the  
3       period of state service on account of which such payment was made
