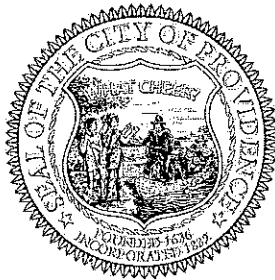


PERSONAL EXPRESSION
