

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 73

Approved January 24, 1995

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 797 of the City Council created a Committee on State Legislation on November 15, 1993; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of said committee was "to track, monitor and testify on legislation affecting the City of Providence"; and

WHEREAS, said Committee as established is inconsistent with the Rules of the City Council adopted on January 2, 1995; and

WHEREAS, Rule 20(c) of said Rules of the City Council adopted January 2, 1995 provides for the creation of all special committees of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes the tracking and monitoring of state legislation and testimony on state legislation affecting the City of Providence is important to the future deliberations of the City Council and the welfare of the citizens of Providence,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That pursuant to Rule 20(c) of the Rules of the City Council a *Special Committee on State Legislation* is hereby created;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the Special Committee on State Legislation shall be charged with the responsibility of tracking and monitoring legislation and testifying before the legislature and its committees regarding all legislation proposed by the City Council and/or affecting the City of Providence;

BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED That said Special Committee shall consist of five (5) members of the City Council who shall be appointed by the President of the City Council pursuant to Rule 20(c) of the Rules of the City Council;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the term of said Special Committee shall expire upon the final adjournment of the January, 1995 session of the Rhode Island General Assembly.

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 74

Approved January 24, 1995

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 281 of the City Council created a Committee on Education on May 10, 1991; and

WHEREAS, the charge of said Committee was "an advisory one for the purpose of promoting communication on school issues with the goal of promoting quality education in the City of Providence"; and

WHEREAS, said Committee as established is inconsistent with the Rules of City Council adopted on January 2, 1995; and

WHEREAS, Rule 27 of said Rules of the City Council provides for the creation of Study Commissions; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes that the study of school issues is important to the future deliberations of the City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That pursuant to Rule 27 of the Rules of the City Council a *Study Commission on Education* is hereby created;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the purpose and charge of said Study Commission shall be to advise the City Council on school issues with the goal of promoting quality education in the City of Providence;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That said Study Commission shall consist of eleven (11) members appointed by the President of the City Council including five (5) members of the City Council, one (1) representative of the Mayor, one (1) representative of the Superintendent of Schools, one (1) member of the American Federation of Teachers, Local #958, and three (3) representatives of the community-wide Parent Teachers Association;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the chairperson and vice-chairperson of said Study Commission shall be appointed by the President of the City Council;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That any and all reports from said study commission shall be submitted to the City Council by filing said reports with the City Clerk;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the term of said study commission shall expire on January 1, 1996.

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 75

Approved January 24, 1995

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 479 of the City Council created a Committee on Junk Cars on July 7, 1993; and

WHEREAS, said Committee was charged with the responsibility "to meet with the Director of Inspection and Standards, the Director of Public Works, the Commissioner of Public Safety and the Chief of the Police Department to make some concrete decisions relative to the management of the removal of abandoned and junked cars from private and city property"; and

WHEREAS, Said Committee as established is inconsistent with the Rules of the City Council adopted on January 2, 1995; and

WHEREAS, Rule 20(c) of said Rules of the City Council provides for the creation of all special committees of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes that the charge issued in said resolution remains of importance to the future deliberations of the City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That pursuant to Rule 20(c) of the Rules of the Providence City Council, a *Special Committee on Management and Removal of Junk Cars* is hereby created;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the charge of said Special Committee shall be to meet with the Director of Inspection and Standards, the Director of Public Works, the Commissioner of Public Safety and the Chief of Police and any other city officials which it may deem necessary for the purpose of advising the City Council as to the proper management and removal of junk cars from private and city property;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That said Special Committee shall consist of five (5) members of the City Council who shall be appointed by the President of the City Council pursuant to said Rule 20(c);

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the term of said Special Committee shall expire on January 1, 1996.
