

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. **618**

Approved November 8, 1963

WHEREAS, there existed upon property now owned by the Providence Redevelopment Agency at its Mashapaug Redevelopment Project certain fences which formed a barrier between said property and trackage of the New York, New Haven and Hartford Railroad, thus affording protection against the possibility of persons straying into the area of railroad traffic, and

WHEREAS, in the program of redevelopment of this portion of the project area, those fences have been demolished thus exposing trespassers to possible danger.
