It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 45-45 of the general laws entitled "Cost
2 of Living Adjustment - Providence Police Department" is hereby
3 repealed in its entirety.

4 SECTION 2. Chapter 45-46 of the general laws entitled "Cost
5 of Living Adjustment - Providence Fire Department" is hereby
6 repealed in its entirety.

7 SECTION 3. Title 45 of the general laws entitled "Towns and
8 Cities" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following chap-
9 ter:

10 CHAPTER 45

11 COST OF LIVING ADJUSTMENTS

12 45-45-1. Providence Police and Fire Departments - Retired
13 Employees. -- All retired Group 2 employees of the city of Provi-
14 dence as defined in section 45-21-10 and all beneficiaries of
15 such Group 2 employees who have retired or deceased shall, on the

1 first day of January of the year following the date of retirement
2 or decease, receive a cost of living retirement adjustment, in
3 addition to the retirement allowance, in an amount equal to three
4 percent (3%) of the retirement allowance, not compounded. In
5 each succeeding year thereafter, during the month of January, the
6 retirement allowance shall be increased an additional three per-
7 cent (3%) of the retirement allowance, not compounded, to be con-
8 tinued during the lifetime of that employee or beneficiary.

9 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon passage.
