
Dear Councilman:

I am writing on behalf of Mr. and Mrs. Anthony Otrando residing on Stanfield Street in Providence. Mr. and Mrs. Otrando are the parents of a child with special needs. Their son is in a wheelchair and needs special transportation to and from school. The street where they reside, Stanfield Street, is a dead-end street which is in need of further development. When the school bus arrives to pick up Joseph it is unable to travel Stanfield Street because it is unable to turn around and exit back on the main street. Therefore, a bus aide must walk the 50-70 feet to the Otrando house and wheel Joseph from the house to the bus.

I am appealing to you to please look into this situation and request that Stanfield Street be developed so that traffic can enter and exit in a normal manner.
