WHEREAS, Dozens of firefighters recently were found to have abnormally high levels of cyanide in their bloodstream; and


WHEREAS, The Fire Department has initiated an investigation as to how and why the cyanide poisoning has occurred; and


WHEREAS, Firefighters are regularly exposed to many toxic gases including carbon monoxide; and

WHEREAS, Special equipment, including masks with filters, now exist to protect firefighters against these toxic fumes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the City Council of the City of Providence does hereby request that the administration of the Fire Department provide firefighters with protective equipment to filter out cyanide, carbon monoxide and other toxic gases; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That upon passage, copies of this resolution be forwarded to the Chief of the Providence Fire Department and to the President of Firefighters Union Local 799.
