WHEREAS, A student at Providence Technical High School "Dixie" earned All-State Honors in baseball and football for three (3) consecutive years, an unprecedented feat. In furtherance of his education, he matriculated at Providence College and while there, continued to display his football and baseball playing ability, and

WHEREAS, "Dixie" later continued his prowess in sports as Field Captain and Leader of "Dixie" Matthews All-Stars, a semi pro baseball team and in football, as a member of the Providence Steam Rollers, The Providence Huskies and later, The New York Brown Bombers, who were under the direction of Fritz Pollard, a famous Brown Alumnus of yesteryear, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Matthews was always busy; solicitous of the welfare of his people, he found time to enter politics and was elected to the Third Ward Democratic Committee, of which, the membership elected him as Secretary, a position he held for 28 years. During this same period, he has given valuable service to the Democratic City Committee and twice has been a delegate to the Democratic Party National Conventions, and

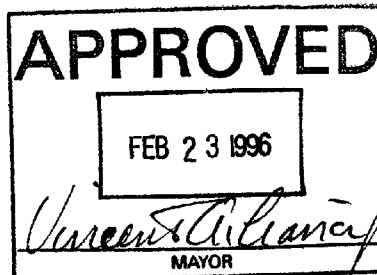
