EFFECTIVE March 3, 2014

WHEREAS, Saints Sahag and Mesrob Armenian Church was consecrated in 1914 and is celebrating her Centennial anniversary; and

WHEREAS, Saint Mesrob Mashdots, one of two patron Saints of the parish, was a devoted priest and monk, and the creator of the Armenian alphabet; and

WHEREAS, Saint Mesrob Mashdots' work was the foundation upon which Armenia's religious, cultural, artistic and literary life blossomed, establishing schools and advancing educational and missionary work; and

WHEREAS, The Capital City of Yerevan has named one of its most prominent major roadways Mesrob Mashdots Boulevard, in honor of the late Saint; and

WHEREAS, On February 17th, he is commemorated as a Saint in both Roman and Eastern churches.


