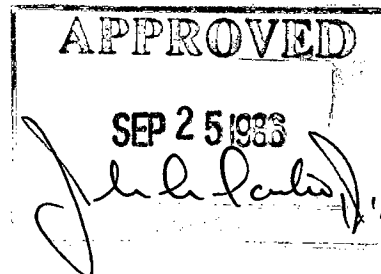


Dear Sir:
