RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 369

Approved July 10, 1973

WHEREAS, Vacancies exist in the offices of one Councilman from the Fifth Ward and one Councilman from the Sixth Ward, within the City of Providence, caused by the resignation of Louis A. Mascia, Ward Five on June 12, 1973, and the resignation of Anthony B. Sciarretta, Ward Six on June 11, 1973, and

WHEREAS, The said vacancies did occur more than one hundred and eighty days before the time of holding the next succeeding regular City election, and

WHEREAS, In accordance with the provisions of Section 12, Chapter 832, of the Public Laws of 1940, known as the "Providence Charter Act of 1940", as amended, by Section 1 of Chapter 2864 of the Public Laws of 1951, approved May 1, 1951, it is mandatory that a Special Election for the purpose of filling such vacancies be held within ninety days of the date of the occurrence of said vacancies,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, RHODE ISLAND, That in compliance with the provisions of governing statutes, the said City Council does hereby order a Special Election to be held for the purpose of filling the vacancies in the office of Councilman from the Fifth Ward of Providence, Rhode Island, caused by the resignation on June 12, 1973 of Louis A. Mascia, and in the office of Councilman from the Sixth Ward of Providence, Rhode Island, caused by the resignation on June 11, 1973, of Anthony B. Sciarretta; said Special Election to be held on the first Wednesday, being also the Fifth day of September, 1973; said date being within ninety (90) days from the date of the occurrence of said vacancies, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Canvassers and Registration and all other officers whose duty it is to prepare for elections are hereby requested to make such preparations for said election as are required by law, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Clerk is directed to cause a duly certified copy of this Resolution to be transmitted to the Board of Canvassers and Registration of the City of Providence, Rhode Island; and a duly certified copy of this Resolution be also transmitted to the State Board of Elections and to the Secretary of State.
