WHEREAS, The City of Providence and the Providence Police Department continue to strive for better and greater public confidence in our Police Department and its activities;

WHEREAS, The innovations of new technology while presenting administrative and procedural challenges to the department continue to enhance and change the way police officers perform their duties and;

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of Public Safety in Section 1001§(A) Item 2 of the Providence Home Rule Charter is charged with and responsible for the enforcement of all laws and ordinances and the promulgation and enforcement of the rules and regulations of the Providence Police Department.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the members of the Providence City Council request that the Commissioner of Public Safety, along with the Attorney General of the State of Rhode Island (in an advisory capacity), promulgate, implement and enforce procedures and protocols for the collection, transfer and storage of any evidence obtained from video surveillance cameras in police vehicles or video surveillance cameras set in fixed locations by the Police Department for the purpose of gathering evidence.
