RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 5210

Approved September 10, 1982

RESOLVED, DECREED AND ORDERED

That the following named street shown as cross-hatched area on the accompanying plan entitled "Providence, Rhode Island, Public Works Dept.-Engineering Office, City Property Section Plan No. 064206, dated July 1, 1982",

VIZ:

Plain Street and Pearl Street (portions), shown as cross-hatched area on the accompanying plan and designated by the letters (A-B-C-D) & (a-b-c), having ceased to be useful to the public and is proposed to be abandoned as a Public Highway, subject to petitioner being responsible for all costs of relocating the utilities and the work on the water line which will be subject to Water Supply Board inspection and approval; the continuation of the public use and maintenance of the subject portion of Plain Street until the New Plain Street is constructed; the petitioner conveying easements acceptable to the Narragansett Electric Company and New England Telephone which will permit the retention of their facilities in existing locations, together with the right to inspect, maintain, operate and replace same; the proposed relocation of the Providence Gas Company's utilities at petitioner's expense and the relocation of sewers and other utilities to be at the expense of the petitioner, and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded, and it is further

ORDERED, That the Director of Public Works be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on the above-named highway abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words, "Not a Public Highway", and it is further

ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree the City Clerk shall cause a notice thereof to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence at least once a week for three successive weeks and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting the above-named highway which has been abandoned, who is known to reside within the State.

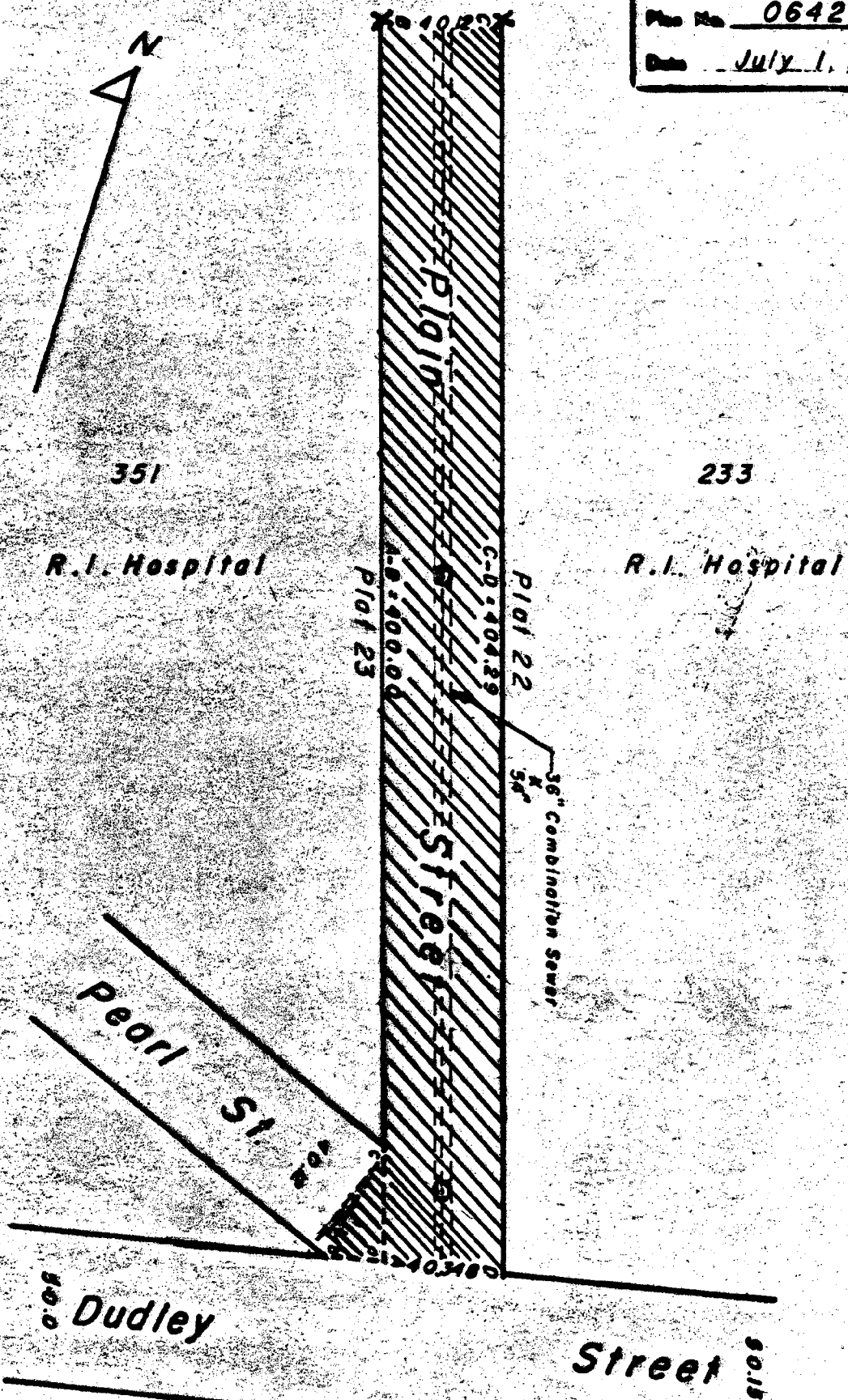

PETITION FOR ABANDONMENT OF
A PORTION OF PLAIN AND PEARL STREETS

Rhode Island Hospital, a corporation organized by the General Assembly of the State of Rhode Island, and having its principal place of business in the City of Providence, in said state, respectfully represents:

FIRST: That your petitioner is the owner in fee of all of the land bordering the portions of Plain and Pearl Streets sought to be abandoned and that said portions of Plain and Pearl Streets are described as follows:

Beginning at the northwesterly intersection of Plain Street and Dudley Street.

Thence running N.24°-16'-50"W. bounded southwesterly by Pearl Street, in part, and Rhode Island Hospital, in part, a distance of four hundred and 00.100 (400.00) feet.

Thence turning an interior angle of 90° and running N.65°-43'-10"E., bounded northwesterly by Plain St., a distance of forty and 12/100 (40.12) feet.

Thence turning an interior angle of 90° and running S.24°-16'-50"E., bounded northeasterly by Rhode Island Hospital, a distance of four hundred four and 29/100 (404.29) feet to the northeasterly intersection of Plain Street and Dudley Street.

Thence turning an interior angle of 83°-53'-50" and running S.71°-49'-20"W., bounded southerly by said Dudley Street, a distance of forty and 348/1000 (40.348) feet to the point or place of beginning.

The last course and the first course form an interior angle of 96°-06'-10".

SECOND: That said portions of Plain and Pearl Streets sought to be abandoned are laid out and designated as the area within points A, B, C, D and E on the accompanying drawing.

THIRD: That said portions of said Streets have ceased to be useful to the public.

FOURTH: That said abandonment is requested for the specific purpose of locating thereon (in part) a new hospital building which is proposed subject to approval by the State of Rhode Island.

FIFTH: That said abandonment, is to be and remain contingent upon approval by the State of Rhode island of the construction of a new hospital building on said site (in part).

SIXTH:: That, if approval is given by the State, as aforesaid, your petitioner will donate land for and pay all expenses for the relocation of the portions of Plain and Pearl Streets sought to be abandoned. Further, your petitioner agrees to grant all reasonably required easements and to pay for all necessary utility relocations both private and municipal.

WHEREFORE YOUR PETITIONER PRAYS that this Honorable City Council declare that said portions of Plain and Pearl Streets have ceased to be useful to the public and that this Honorable City Council will abandon said streets.



Gentlemen:

The City Plan Commission, at its August 4, 1982 monthly meeting, reviewed and evaluated the subject referral which contained a request by the Rhode Island Hospital for the abandonment of portions of Plain and Pearl Streets.

A field inspection revealed that the portion of Plain Street proposed for abandonment is a 40 foot wide improved public right-of-way with sidewalks and curbs. It abuts a parking lot at the westerly side and Rhode Island Hospital Complex at the easterly side. The portion of Pearl Street proposed for abandonment contains 420 square feet of street area in a triangular shape and is located at the intersection of Plain and Dudley Streets.

Plain Street, which runs southerly from Point Street across Dudley and Public Streets to Potters Avenue, is a major two way public thoroughway that serves the Rhode Island Hospital Complex and the medical facilities. In view of its importance, the petitioner has proposed to relocate that subject portion of Plain Street by creating a new right-of-way running westerly from Plain Street to the intersection of Gay and Pearl Streets.

On the basis of the facts presented by its staff and the petitioner, the Commission voted to recommend to the Committee on Public Works that the subject petition be approved contingent upon (1) the continuation of the public use and maintenance of the subject portion of Plain Street until the new Plain Street is constructed; (2) granting of the Rhode Island Certificate of Needs; and (3) an evaluation of traffic impacts on Gay Street by the City Traffic Engineer.

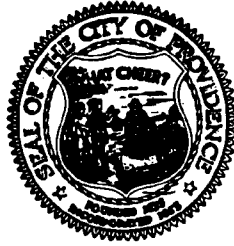

Enclosed are the following two drawings:

- (1) A reduced size drawing showing the portion of Plain Street to be abandoned and the footprint of the new proposed structure.
- (2) A very preliminary utility relocation drawing prepared by Bill Johnston of Thompson Consultants, Inc.

It is our intent to reroute gas lines from existing Plain Street diagonally along the face of the new building, generally following the entrance drive to Dudley Street. Lines which may require reconnection to Plain Street will be routed parallel to Dudley Street and reconnected in the vicinity of the existing Plain Street-Dudley Street intersection. An easement will be provided for the relocation route.

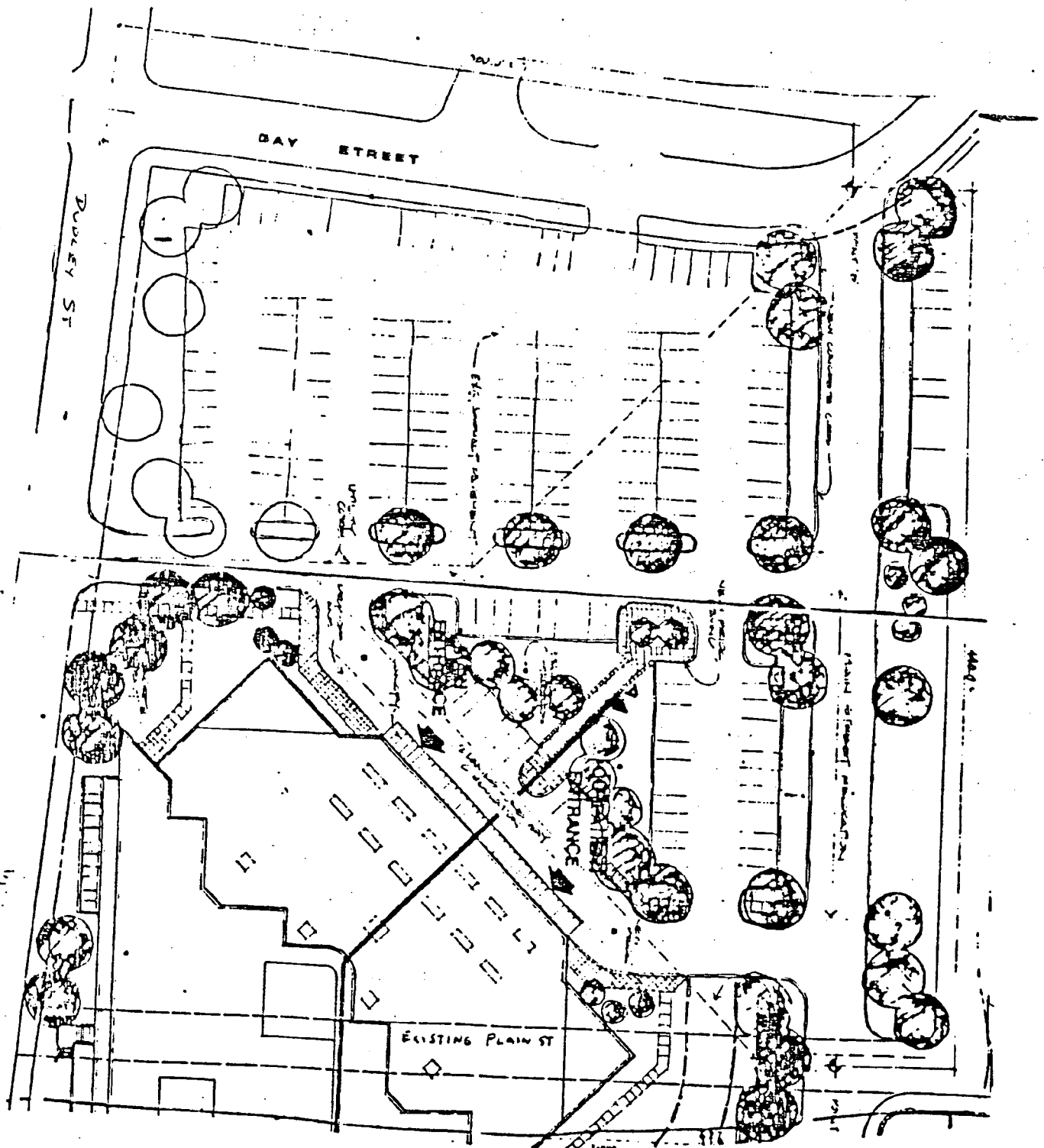

After reviewing your basic layout of the proposed relocation of utilities, the Providence Gas Company is agreeable to the relocation at others' expense.

We presently have a 20" CI main and a 6" CI main in Plain Street. We plan only to relocate the 20" CI main and will permanently abandon the 6" main, tying the ends of the 6" main into the 20" main. This is going to require approximately 725' of 20" steel main.


All costs relative to those relocations will be borne by Women & Infants as part of their building construction budget.

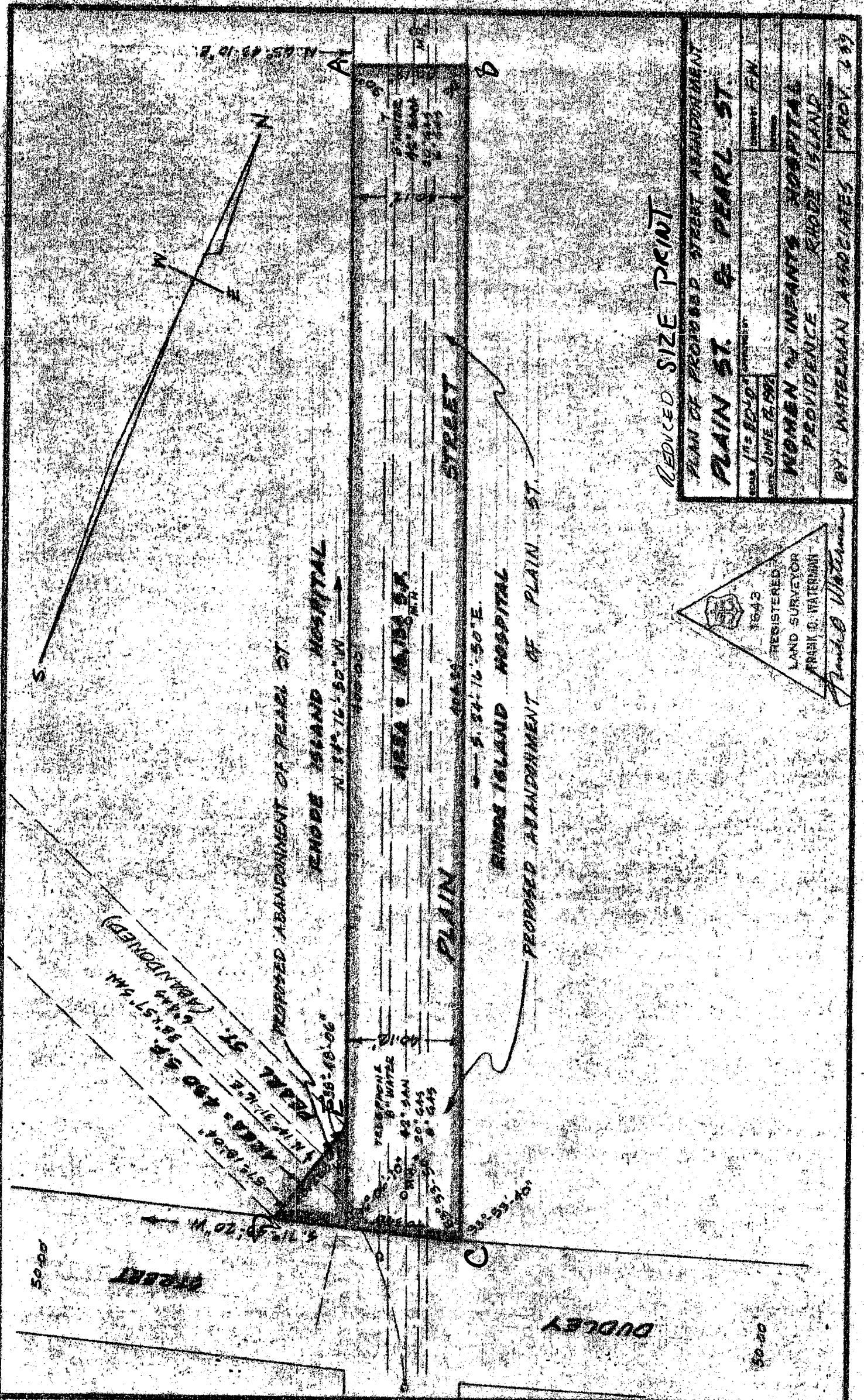
