

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved December 7, 2018

RESOLVED, That the following Minute of the life and character of the late Carol Romano, Member of the Providence City Council from September 5, 1996 to December 31, 2006, is hereby adopted, ordered, and inscribed on the records of the City Council and a duly certified copy be transmitted to the family of the deceased.

MINUTE

Carol Romano was born December 25, 1939 to Mario and Gilda (DiNunzio) Volpe. She was a lifelong Democrat and was an active supporter of various Providence candidates since 1970. With her late husband, John Romano, she co-owned and operated Atlantic Driving Training Academy, a family-owned driver education school.

In 1996, Carol ran in the special election to fill the Ward 4 Council seat left vacant by the passing of the late Councilman James A. Petrosinelli. Winning the race with 864 votes - or 87 percent of the 990 votes cast, Carol became the first woman to represent Ward 4 on the Providence City Council. She held this role and served the City and its residents for 10 years, having a place on the Committee on Urban Redevelopment, Renewal and Planning and the Committee on Finance.


Carol was also a lifelong member of St. Ann Church with her late husband, serving as a communicant and an Eucharistic minister.




