# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 516

Approved August 15, 1980

WHEREAS, Anthony J. Carello, Medical Technologist at the Veterans Administration Hospital displayed promptitude at a time when a life was in danger on July 6, 1980, and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Jackie Perkins, while in the process of planting cultures in an isolation compartment of that hospital, became endangered when a gas explosion occurred, igniting her clothes and placing her life in grave peril, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Carello, in maintaining great fortitude to this mishap, instantly placed Mrs. Perkins under an emergency shower nearby, turned the water on and extinguished the fire, and

WHEREAS, This speedy action on his part was instrumental in confining the burns to certain areas of Mrs. Perkins' body, thereby lessening the extent of her injury and suffering,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Members of the City Council hereby extend to Anthony J. Carello, their sincere Congratulations for his tenacity and alertness in the rescue of Mrs. Jackie Perkins from severe bodily injury, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That upon the adoption of this Resolution by the City Council and its approval by His Honor the Mayor, the City Clerk is directed to transmit a duly engrossed copy to Anthony J. Carello that he be aware of the esteem in which he is held.
